REPORT OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE TO THE ANNUAL MEETING, 1926.

The Executive Committee, after its election and pursuant to Article XVI of the Constitution, selected Mr. Gustavus T. Kirby, Columbia, as Referee and Mr. H. Jamison Swarts, Pennsylvania, as Manager of the Forty-ninth Annual Track and Field Championship Meeting and also appointed the officials for such meeting.

Pursuant to Article IX of the Constitution, the Executive Committee appointed Mr. A. Jocelyn H. Magrath, New York University, Graduate Secretary-Treasurer, and Mr. James A. Taylor, Columbia, Assistant to the President. Pursuant to the same Article, the President, immediately after his election, appointed the following Advisory Committee:

The report of Mr. Russell W. Lynch, Manager of the Fourth Annual Indoor Championship Athletic Meeting, was approved, showing receipts of \$8,562.62; expenditures of \$4,166.83 and a net profit of \$4,395.79.



YALE UNIVERSITY TRACK TEAM.

Owing to the graduation of Mr. H. Jamison Swarts, Pennsylvania, President of the Association, it became necessary to select a new President under the provision of Article IX of the Constitution, and at a meeting of the Association, held October 18, 1925, Mr. E. Allan Graham, Pennsylvania, was duly elected President.

The Executive Committee, pursuant to Article XVII of the Constitution, appointed Mr. Gustavus T. Kirby, Columbia, to be Referee and Mr. Russell W. Lynch, Columbia, Manager of the Sixteenth Annual Cross Country Runs.

The Executive Committee approved the report of Mr. Russell W. Lynch, Columbia, Manager of the Sixteenth Annual Cross Country Runs, showing receipts of \$297, and a permanent investment of \$38.87; expenditures of \$341.72 and a net cost to the Association for the runs of \$10.85.

The Executive Committee, pursuant to Article XIX of the Constitution, selected Mr. Gustavus T. Kirby, Columbia, as Referee and Mr. Russell W. Lynch, Columbia, as Manager of the Fifth Annual Indoor Championship Athletic Meeting.

The Executive Committee denied the application of Alfred University for membership in the Association.

The Executive Committee recommends to the Association the admission of Manhattan College to membership in the Association.

The Executive Committee approved a report of Mr. H. Jamison Swarts, Pennsylvania, as Manager of the 1925 Track and Field Championship Meeting, showing receipts of \$9,520.62; expenditures of \$4,497.63 and net profits of \$5,122.99, with an unpaid balance for entry fees of members of \$155.50.

The Executive Committee appointed as delegates to the A.A.U. Convention, held November 15, 1925, at Pittsburgh, Messrs. Gustavus T. Kirby, Columbia; A. Jocelyn H. Magrath, New York University, and Rupert B. Thomas Jr., Princeton.


The report of the Treasurer for the fiscal year, March 7, 1925 to March 6, 1926, showed: Balance in bank of \$11,636.69, March 7, 1925; receipts of \$11,125.22; expenditures of \$11,789.96, and a balance in the treasury of \$10,971.95.

The Executive Committee recommends to the Association action on various amendments to the Constitution, By-Laws and Rules which are submitted in the annexed statement and which is a part of this report.



FIFTIETH ANNUAL TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIP MEETING.

The Fiftieth Annual Track and Field Championship Meeting was held at Soldiers Field, Cambridge, on May 28 and 29, 1926. It was fittingly the most successful meeting ever held by the I.C.A.A.A.A., both in the point of competition and attendance. Save for intermittent strong winds

the weather was ideal. The attendance numbered 14,600, and was the largest in the history of the association.

It was noteworthy that in spite of the intense competition of fifty years, four records were broken and allowed and three other records were broken but disallowed because of an assisting wind. In the eleven events the performances were better than the preceding year, which in turn had provided a remarkable series of competitions.

The Championship was won by Southern California for the second year in succession with 35½ points, including four first places. Stanford was second with 25½ points, including two first places. Yale was third with 25 1-3 points or 1-6 of a point behind second.
