

SULLIVAN MEDAL TO LAWSON LITTLE

W. Lawson Little Jr. of California, United States and British amateur golf champion for the past two years, was voted the outstanding athlete and sportsman for 1935 in the balloting for the James E. Sullivan Memorial Trophy, presented each year by the Amateur Athletic Union of the United States.

Mrs. Helen Wills Moody, another Californian, seven times woman tennis champion of the United States and winner of the British title at Wimbledon an equal number of times, finished second in the voting. Percy Beard of the New York A.C., national high hurdles champion, was third. The final results follow:

This annual award, begun by the Amateur Athletic Union in 1930, goes to the competing athlete "who by his performance, his example and his influence as an amateur and as a man has done most during the past year to advance the cause of sportsmanship." The winner is determined by a tribunal of 600 sports leaders throughout the United States.

The first move of the A.A.U. in the balloting is to request the members of the tribunal to choose three candidates together with the reasons for their selection. From the names turned in, the committee select the ten considered most worthy, resubmit them to the tribunal, and three names are picked in order of preference by the sports leaders. First place counts five points, second counts three, and third one.

Of the three leaders the Sullivan Award Committee had this to say, in part:

"W. Lawson Little, Jr.—Amateur golf champion of the United States and Great Britain for two successive years, a feat never before attained by any golfer. Member of the last two Walker Cup teams. Won all of his matches in decisive fashion. Possesses strong character, meeting the test of gameness and fighting ability under the most trying conditions. His manner was unimpeachable before and during his astonishing climb to the top of the world of golf. He is modest, a gentleman and a credit to amateur athletics."

"Mrs. Helen Wills Moody—One of the most gracious sportswomen of all time, with all the qualities so desired in sportsmanship. Her courageous return to top ranking in her field after ill health, and her undemonstrative attitude toward those who criticized her, as well as her silence to these criticisms both before and after triumph, have demonstrated her high qualities of sportsmanship. A thorough amateur. Has consistently refused to capitalize on her athletic ability reputation. Modest in victory, courageous in defeat and considerate of her opponents."

"Percy Beard—Outstanding competitor in track for eight years. Holds world records for the 120 yards and 110 meters high hurdles. The present American high hurdle champion. Has always acted the part of a true sportsman whether he wins or loses. He is modest in victory, courageous in defeat and always considerate of his opponents. He is as outstanding in his character and leadership qualities as in athletic ability. As a member of the faculty of Alabama Polytechnic Institute at Auburn, Ala., he is a force for good on the campus and outside the university sphere as well. Although out of college for several years he still continues to compete for the love of the game and maintain his place among the leaders. On and off the athletic field he symbolizes a fine spirit of sportsmanship. His ideals of amateurism are of the best. Soft spoken and quiet mannered, he nevertheless has the confidence that figures in the make-up of every champion."



THE OLYMPIC VILLAGE

"Village" is almost too modest a name for this project, which the Defence Force of the Reich is erecting near Doberitz as its gift to the athletic youth of the world who will compete in the XIth Olympic Games in 1936. Covering an area of 140 acres, it is about the size of an ordinary rural village. One-fourth comprises thick woodland with pine, beech and oak trees, and combined with the scenic beauties of the land—its gentle slopes, picturesque valley and lake, which offer refuge to bird and beast—it gives one the feeling of being in the midst of nature. But its systematic planning, its modern comforts and up-to-date sanitation, its drainage, etc., give it the aspect of a modern city.

One hundred and forty one-story dwellings are being constructed, each containing 16, 20 or 24 beds. About 3000 guests will find accommodation here, two being assigned to each room. Each house contains baths and showers, a club-room opening out onto a terrace, and telephone service. Refrigerators and all modern equipment will be installed in every house, and two stewards will be at the service of the inhabitants to provide light refreshments. The houses are of durable stone construction.

Only the men participants, the coaches and their assistants, the physicians, trainers and chefs for the various groups will live in the Village. The women athletes taking part in the Games will have their own home in the neighborhood of the Olympic Stadium. Four members from each National Olympic Committee may also live in the Village, and a number of the referees who are sent by International Sport Federations will be accommodated.

At the Western Conference 1935 championships Owens equaled one world record and bettered three, all on the same day, May 25. He ran the 100 yards in 9.4s., the 220 in 20.3s., the 220 low hurdles in 22.6s., and broad jumped 26ft.8 1-4in. Peacock (the runner at the right in the group) won the A.A.U. national 100 meters run in 10.2s., aided by the wind, and he cleared 26ft. 3in. to win the running broad jump title.






