SPAL PREVIEW

There's nothing like a good pennant race to stir up enthusiasm and the South Peninsula Athletic League appears to be in for just such a scramble this fall.

No less than five of the eight teams are rated definite contenders for the crown and it appears doubtful any school will get through the season unscathed.

The contenders in the SPAL pennant race.

Defending champion Palo Alto, working on the streak of 15 games without a defeat. QB Don McPhail's accurate arm and HB Mike McClelland's quick bursts are the major weapons.

Menlo-Atherton. Howard Costello, his league's Coach of the Year two of the past three seasons, will build the Bears' attack around bruising fullback Bob Kennedy.

Carlmont, Joining the league from the NPAL, has a dangerous aerial combination in QB Ron Sweet and end Chris Jessen and a tough runner in fullback Bill Kutzer.

Cubberley, A new entrant, has the most explosive squad. The Cougars can strike on passes from quarterback Ted Tollner to ends Byron Tani and Mike Nichols or on dashes by halfbacks Dave Kilbourne and Ernie Stevenson.

San Jose has the 1956 passing champion, QB Dave Serrano, back to go along with the running of 200 - pound fullback Jim Cadile.

Darkhorse honors belong to Sequoia, which may field a nearly all junior team and a sophomore, Rich Trammell, at the key tailback position.

Lincoln and Willow Glen are building. A. B. Barrera will handle the Lions' multiple offense with tackle Loren Marburg leading the line. HB Jan Gerrard and center Tom Conon are the only lettermen returning at Willow Glen.

SCVAL PREVIEW

With seven starters returning off the team that tied for the last year, who else but James Lick High could be favored to win the 1957 Santa Clara Valley Athletic League football championship.

Coach Al Cementina will present a lineup studded with such luminaries as 1956 Back of the Year Chon Gallegos, end Bill Turner and guard Abbie Morales.

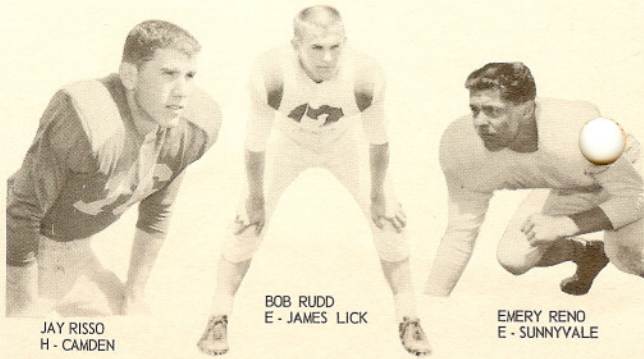
While Lick looks to its finest year, there will still be plenty of opposition. Santa Clara, featuring a fine pair of ends in Larry Guilford and Otis Gresham; and Fremont, with a powerful running attack headed by Jim Zamlisch and Don Hufford, figure prominently in the race.

Camden will probably present the biggest threat of the three newcomers in the league. The Cougars won the informal Little Big Four jayvee conference last year and uncovered some sparklers in fullback Greg Rocha, guard Dave Madril and end Mike Profit.

The other new schools -- Los Altos and Sunnyvale -- will be shallow but may have outstanding backs in Bob Overman and Jim Going for the Knights and Sam Avila and John Dutra for the Jets.

Campbell, though rebuilding with a young team, may stir up trouble with the running of Dave Alvarez. Los Gatos, hit hard by losses from factors other than graduation, will bank chiefly on its master split-T quarter back, Jim Liggett.

Mountain View has just one starter -- tackle Jerry Borrego -- back from its co-championship club and may start as many as eight underclassmen. Washington, with a new coach, is an unknown quality.

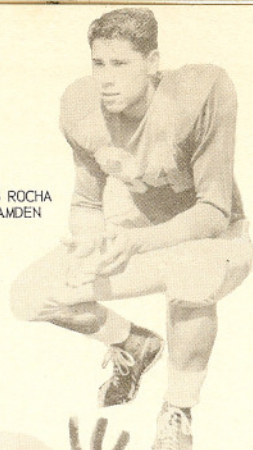

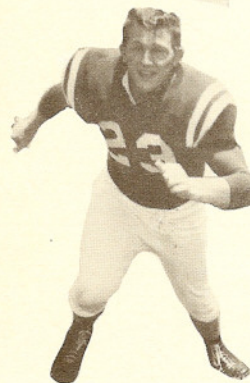
