**7-Foot Jump**

BERKELEY—Jeff Chase and Gene Johnson of Santa Clara Valley Youth Village and coach Darrel Horn of Athens Athletic Club turned in outstanding marks in a three-way meet with California Frosh at Edwards Field Saturday morning.

Chase set a stadium record of 16-0 $\frac{1}{4}$  in winning the pole vault, breaking the mark of 15-9 set by Brian Sterberg and Mel Hein in 1963.

Johnson, former California star, set a new stadium standard of 7-0 $\frac{3}{4}$  in the high jump, breaking the record of 7-0 set by John Thomas in 1960.

Horn triple jumped 51-4 $\frac{1}{2}$ , breaking the stadium mark of 50-11 $\frac{1}{2}$  set by Luther Hayes in 1960, and he also won the long jump at 24-7 $\frac{1}{4}$ .
