

Walker, Smith Share Mt. Sac Award

It was an all-star show without a real star.

The eighth annual Mt. San Antonio Relays Saturday failed to produce a world record, or even an American record. Yet, the 10,000 fans saw a profusion of fine performances.

Item: Art Walker of the Striders triple-jumped 53 feet 10 1/4 inches, best in the world this year and the second longest ever by an American.

Tom Farrell, former St. John's College runner, competing unattached, sped the 880 in 1:47.9, equalling the fastest time of 1966 posted recently by USC's Dennis Carr.

Tommie Smith of San Jose unleashed fantastic anchor legs in the 440 and 880 relays. He just failed to give the Spartans victory in the 440 after making up eight yards on the Striders' Larry Dunn, then was clocked in 20 flat as he "lost" Fred Kuller of the Striders and Art Carter of New Mexico in the last 40 yards to turn a three-way 880 fight into a 10-yard triumph.

Faulty baton exchanges prevented those races from cracking records. The Striders won in 40.4, the Spartans in 1:23.8.

Walker and Smith were chosen the athletes of the meet.

John Pennel of the Striders and Sam Kirk of the Pasadena AA vaulted 17 feet, but were thwarted trying 17-5 for a world mark.

Ralph Boston of the Striders long-jumped 26-4 1/4, but was pressed by Gayle Hopkins of the Pasadena AA, who did 26-2 3/4.

Jim Grelle and George Young got identical clockings of 14:10.8 in the 5,000, though a Polaroid photo plainly showed the veteran Grelle winning by two yards after coming from behind.

USC's Gary Carlson got off the best discus throw of his young life—195.0 1/2—to beat three-time Olympic champion Al Oerter, whose best Saturday was 194.8.

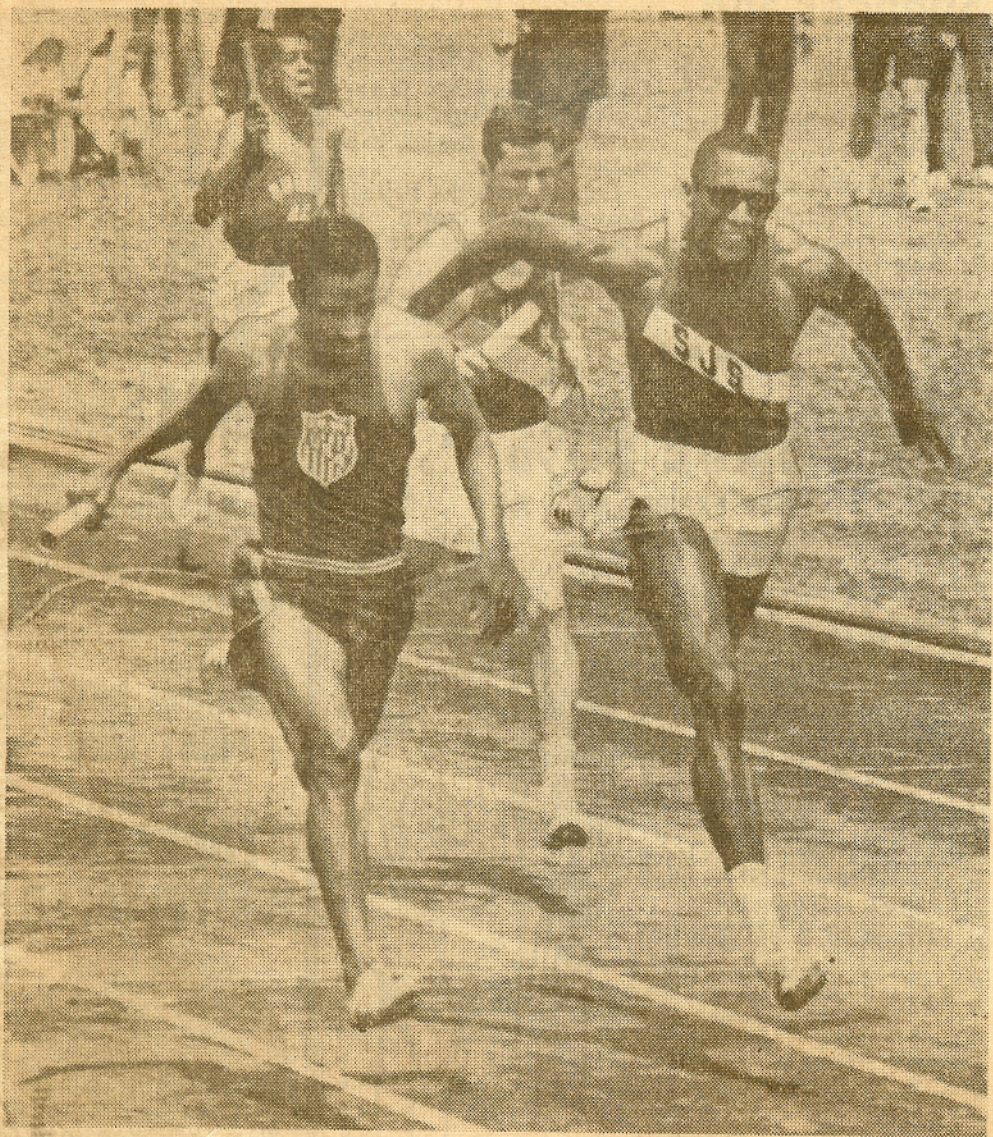

ers, to all appearances to the 10,000 spectators, won the event. The only trouble was that Whitney, after two false starts, had been disqualified.

Whitney took off after the gun sounded anyway, but the official winner was Vance Peterson of Occidental in 51.2.

The 5,000 meter event was a three way race between Greele, Young and Ron Larrieu. On the

final lap, however, with 300 yards to go, Young suddenly burst into a 10 yard lead, with Grelle second.

The slender blond runner from Portland, Ore., put on his familiar and devastating final kick, however, to overhaul Young. Both were timed at 14:10.8. But Grelle's margin was decisive and many observers thought the second place time was inaccurate.

made futile attempts at a new world standard of 17-5; a swift 1:47.9 half mile by Tommy Farrell, the NCAA champion from St. John's of New York; a 26-4/4 long jump by Ralph Boston, and a totally unanticipated discus victory for USC's Gary Carlsen.

Given a sampling of Smith's prowess in the 440 relay, where his built-in gear shift barely missed making up all of a 9-yard deficit on the SC Striders' Larr Dunn, and in the 880 baton carry, where Tommy literally blew down all opposition with an

unofficial 20 flat clocking for his 220, the fans were somewhat disappointed that San Jose State cancelled from the mile relay.

Coach Bud Winter explained that a slight leg injury to John Bambury during the running of the 880 relay, plus smog annoyance decided him on sending the Spartans out in the longer race.

"Since this was a non-scoring meet, we decided to save it all for the Fresno Relays (May 13-14)," Winter said.

Inferior passing plagued the Spartans in the 440 relay which the Striders won in a comparatively slow 40.4. One more stride, however, and Smith would have whipped his man.

BUT THERE was plenty of working room in the 880. Starting off a yard behind Art Carter of New Mexico and Fred Kuller of the Striders, Smith let 'em think they were going places until they were 50 yards from home then went swishing by to win by 10 jet propelled strides.

Another programmed feature, a mile duel between Oregon veterans Dyrol Burleson and Jim Grelle, didn't come about because Jim decided to go into the 5,000 meters instead.

Consequently, a sub-four minute mile didn't go into the books as Dyrol loafed home in 4:01.4.

But the 5,000 did develop into an unexpected scorcher as Olympian George Young, America's top steeplechaser, battled Grelle furiously through the entire last 440 and yielded at the tape by less than a yard in 14:10.8. Young earned the same clocking.

Prime record maker was Walker, whose triple jump broke both the stadium and relays standard he set at 53 1/2 last year.

Farrell's 880 time sliced six tenths of a second off Jerry Siebert's two-year-old 1:48.5 relays standard while Pennel added exactly ten inches to what had been the Mt. Sac mark, set by then Marine Dave Tork four years ago.
