High produced a great double performance, long jumping 24-5 for second place, and triple jumping 48-7½ for fourth place. Both were lifetime bests for Rodgers who had previously done 23-10½ and 49-4¾.

In other highlights, John Bakkenen of Athens flipped the discus 184-11, and two Spartan athletes came through with their career bests. Rapidly-improving Pat Moran won the long jump at 24-9 and had another jump of 24-1 and Rich Saunders added seven feet to his previous best in the discus at 168-1.
