

Aztecs Not So Shy About Setting Records

FRESNO — San Diego State was well on its way toward retaining the college division championship as the 40th annual West Coast Relays began Friday night.

The Aztecs not only were scoring heavily, but revising the record book as well.

Don Shy set a meet record of 13.7 in the 120 hurdles prelims, then won in a wind-aided 13.6. He also took the long jump with 24 feet, 8³/₄ inches.

Houston Ridge upped the meet shot put mark to 60-8³/₄.

Wilbur Smith bagged the 100 in 9.6, equalling the meet record. But his time was disallowed be-

cause of an aiding wind.

The Aztecs also finished first in the distance medley relay with a clocking of 10:11.4.

World class performers take over the show today and are expected to lure a capacity crowd of 14,000.

The headliners include Randy Matson, world shot put record holder who'll be making his first Fresno appearance; world long jump record holder Ralph Boston; 17-foot vaulters John Pennel, Bob Seagren, Sam Kirk and maybe Paul Wilson; and San Jose State's sprint sensation, Tommie Smith, who'll anchor three relay teams.
