

Santa Cruz easily carried off first honors at the ninth annual field and track meet of the Coast Counties Athletic league, held at Sherwood park, in this city, last Saturday afternoon. The victorious athletes of the surf city piled up a total of 46 points. Hollister finished second with 35, Salinas third with 18, Pacific Grove fourth with 9, Gilroy fifth with 6, and Monterey sixth with 3.

The meet called out the largest attendance of recent years, and was highly successful from every point of view. Competition was keen, resulting in the establishing of five new league records. These were in the discus throw, the mile run, the 100-yard dash, the 220 low hurdles and the 880-yard dash.

Shaw of Hollister threw the discus 108 feet 4 inches, beating the old record of 106 feet 8 inches by 20 inches.

Campbell of Santa Cruz clipped 13 seconds off the mile run by doing the distance in 4:41.5. The old record was 4:54.5.

In the first of the 100-yard dash Lynn of Hollister sprinted the distance in 10.1.5, reducing the record one-fifth of a second.

Sharp of Pacific Grove won the 220-yard low hurdles in 27.2.5 seconds, clipping two-fifths of a second off the old record.

Damkroger of Santa Cruz sprinted 880 yards in 2:11.5, beating the old record of 2:12 by 1.5.

High jump—Hartnell of Salinas, first; Lynn of Hollister and Churchill of Pacific Grove tied for second. Height—5 feet 6½ inches.

220-yard low hurdles—Sharp of Pacific Grove, first; Steinbeck of Hollister, second; Griffin of Salinas, third. Time—27 2-5.

880-yard run—Damkroger of Santa Cruz, first; Lynn of Hollister, second; Watson of Santa Cruz, third. Time—2:11 4-5.
