

Salinas Finishes Second In Annual Coast Counties Athletic League Track and Field Meet

Santa Cruz high school won the big coast counties athletic league track and field meet, held in the surf city Saturday afternoon, by a score that was greater than the combined points made by her five opponents. Salinas put up a game fight and ended in second place.

Mile run—Won by Marlin (S.C.), Izant (S.C.) second, Montague third. Time 5 min. 8 sec. This time was considered good, owing to the wind.

100 yard dash—Won by Phillips (S.C.), Church (S.) second, Dake (S.C.) third. Time 11 1-3 sec.

High hurdle, 120 yards—Won by Church (S.), Wolfe (S.C.) second, Show (H.) third. Time 19 2-3 sec.

440-yard dash—Won by Phillips (S.C.), Hodges and VanGorder (S.C.) tied for second. Time 55.4 sec.

Shot put—Won by Anderson (K.C.), Terwilliger (S.C.) second, Irvine (S.) third. Distance 40 ft.

330-yard dash—Won by Phillips (S.C.), Greene (S.) second, Hodges (S.C.) third. Time 24.4 sec.

Broad jump—Won by Dake (S.C.), Wolfe (S.C.) second, Cooper (S.) third. Distance 18 ft. 5 3-8 in.

Low hurdles—Won by Skow (H.), Church (S.) second, Wolfe (S.C.) third. Time 28 2-3 sec.

Half mile—Won by Izant (S.C.), Marlin (S.C.) second, Earl (H.) third. Time 2 min. 11 1-3 sec.

(A record in this event was made last year by Paget. Santa Cruz has won the half mile event for the past fifteen years.)

High jump—Won by McEachren (M.), Austin (S.) second, Thorup and Irvine (both of S.) tied for third. Height 5 feet 5.5 in.

Relay—Won by Santa Cruz, Salinas second, King City third. Time 2 min. 31 sec. This was over a course of three-fourths of a mile, run by six men, each man covering one-eighth of a mile.
