

Loss In Midget Relay Deprives Salinas Of Clean Sweep In Track

Coach Harry Shipkey's Salinas Cowboys fulfilled their early season promise by winning the CCAL heavyweight championship last Saturday afternoon at Monterey.

The Cowboys made 41 1-3 points to only 19 for Hollister, indicating the comparative strength and ease with which they won. It was mostly due to the large number of second and third places they made that the Cowboys came out victorious. The Cowboys made only five first places out of fourteen, but nearly every one of the fourteen Cowboys in the meet succeeded in winning one or more places. Smith scored an unexpected win in the football throw, but could only place in a tie for third in the pole vault. Slade won the 440, but was upset in the broad jump, when Taylor of King City won with a leap of 21 feet, three and three-fourths inches. This was decidedly an upset as Slade has done 21 feet, seven inches. Maurer made a tie for first place in the pole vault with McGill of Pacific Grove. The heavy wind and poor runway was a handicap in this event and the winning height was only 10 feet, six inches. Parker's victory in the discus and the win of the Cowboy relay team completed the Cowboy firsts.

COWBABES COP FIRST

The Salinas Cowbabe lightweights defeated King City 32 to 27, for the CCAL championship in this division. Although the Cowbabes won only two first places—Talley's in 220, and that of the relay team—they made enough places to win. Talley made a second in the 100 and one in the discus to be the chief scorer for Salinas. They heavy wind and the very poor track caused the many upsets and the poor records.

The Salinas Cowbabe midgets lost the relay for the first time this year and thereby suffered the first defeat this season. With only the relay to run, Salinas trailed Hollister by one-half point, 12½ to 12. King City won the relay, however, while Hollister was third. The five points gave King City 14 points and the midget championship. Hollister was second and Salinas third.

Only two new records were set. Young clipped 2.3 seconds off the old 880 record, negotiating the half mile in 2:01.9. The other record broken was the midget pole vault. Gunn of Salinas went three inches higher than he had ever before to earn a tie with the spectacular Winkle of Hollister. The new record is 10 feet, five inches, one and three-fourths inches higher than the old record made by Winkle last

year. Cole of Hollister made the old 880 in 1933.

All those who placed in last Saturday's meet will travel to Stanford next Saturday for the Californi Interscholastic Meet.
