Twelve Marks Made In S. C. Valley Meet

Bino Chiado Stands Out In Lightweight Division.

Although he was the center of attraction in yesterday's Santa Clara Valley Athletic league track finals at Los Gatos, Harold Davis, Live Oak sprint dynamo, was forced to share the limelight with one Bino Chiado, Gilroy 120-pounder.

Little Bino set a new record in the broad jump, took firsts in both the high jump and 100-yard dash, and ran anchor lap on his team's winning relay team.

Although he was alone in the high jump, Bino failed to scale his own height of 5 feet 9¾ inches made in last year's meet. He stopped at 5 feet 7¾ inches to compete in the century.

BROAD JUMP RECORD.

His mark in the broad jump eclipsed the 20 foot 1½ inch jump made by Bob Rhoades of Live Oak in 1936 by 8½ inches.

Davis lived up to expectations and again broke his own 100 and 220-yard dash records which he made in last week's trials.

Harold turned the century in 9.7 seconds equalling his time made in the Junior P. A. A. several weeks ago and bettering his own record of 9.8 seconds.

HAS MUSCLE TROUBLE.

In the 220, Harold had a wide margin coming into the stretch but he suddenly developed a tightness in his leg muscles.

However, he came through to break the tape first in 21.4 seconds to crack his previous Valley league record for the distance by five-tenths of a second.

Following the race Harold complained of his tightness and expressed confidence that if it had not occurred, he might have run the distance in faster time.

LOS GATOS, GILROY WIN.

In the final point standings, Gilroy came through to win the three lightweight divisions as was predicted, but a badly underdogged Los Gatos unlimited team doggedly refused to give up the varsity title that they have held for the past seven years.

The "Cats" scored only three first places on the 14 event program, but placed 22 times to run up a total of 43½ points.

Eddie Paske of Los Gatos turned in the surprise performance of the day in winning both the 880 and mile runs to account for two of his team's first places.

SWEEP 880 RUN.

Los Gatos men crossed the line one, two, three in the mile and then the same trio of Paske, Purdy and Sporleder took first, third and fourth in the 880.

Newell Rocha came through as was expected and won both the low and high hurdles for Washington, setting a new record of 16.6 inches in the high barriers.

Rocha's new mark shaded the record established by Bradford of Los Gatos in last year's annual renewal of the Valley league meet. Bradford set up a time of 16.9 seconds.

CAMPBELL DARK-HORSE.

A comparative dark-horse, Leiland Vaughan of Campbell attained 5 feet 11¾ inches to crack a 10-year-old high jump record of 5 feet 10½ inches set in 1928 by Carter of Los Gatos.

All told, 27 records were broken in the four divisions, 15 last week and 12 yesterday.

Others to establish new marks included: Ayer, Gilroy, 130-pound high hurdles in 16.4 seconds. Old mark made by Edward of Los Gatos in 1937 was 19.0.

880-YARD RECORD.

Quintano, Gilroy, 130-pound 880-yard run in 2 minutes 7.7 seconds. Old mark of 2:07.8 held by Rouble of Fremont, established in 1936.

Johnson, Gilroy, 120-pound discus throw of 140 feet 9 inches. Old record of 132 feet 6½ inches held by Wilson of Mt. View and established in 1937.

Pine, Washington, 110-pound 100-yard dash in 10.7 seconds. Old record set at 10.8 seconds and held jointly by Ishikawa and Ishimura, both of Mt. View.
