

# Lincoln Winner Of Lightweight Division Crown

## Carroll Is Triple Winner For Lincoln

Scoring heavily in the field events and showing surprising all-around strength, Los Gatos' Wildcats upset Lincoln high to win the Valley league varsity track title yesterday at Spartan field with a grand total of 41 points.

Lincoln, pre-meet favorite, finished second with 33, followed by Campbell and Mt. View, who tied for third with 24.

Led by little Donnie Carroll, who was a triple winner and the star of the meet, Lincoln won the lightweight meet with 48½ points. Santa Clara was second with 25, and Gilroy third with 19.

### Carroll Is Star

Carroll stole most of the show from Murray Collins and Los Gatos' surprising varsity squad. He broad-jumped 22 feet 2 inches for the outstanding mark of the day, and followed up by winning the lightweight 220 in 22.7, pretty fair time for a 15-year-old, and tossed the eight pound shot 48 feet 2½ inches. His mark in the broad jump is one of the best of the season and surpasses many of the college jumpers on the coast.

Collins, one of two double winners in the varsity class, started the meet off to a fast pace by winning the mile in 4:35.9. His nearest rival, Fred Frevert of Campbell, was 175 yards back when the Lincoln star broke the tape. His mark, while not one of his best performances, was two full seconds under the Valley league record. Collins' time will not go into the books as a new league standard, however, since official league competition has been suspended for the duration. Carroll's leap in the broad jump, a foot better than the league's varsity record, likewise will not win recognition on the official league books. Collins came back to win the 880 in 2:03.8.

### Strong In Field

Hint of the Los Gatos power came to the front in the 440, where the Cats ran one-two with Bob Chambers and Bill Cox leading the pack home. From then on, Los Gatos picked up points in almost every event, winning three of the six field events. Merrill Jenkins scored a double in the low hurdles and the high jump, while Marcus Tatum won the pole vault and Fred Hill took the discus with a tremendous heave of 123 feet 4 inches.

Bob Barry of Mt. View was a surprise winner in the 100 yard dash, and then brought the Eagles from third place to win the varsity relay.
