Redondo Wins State Meet; Helwig Stars

Highlighted by the record mile relay team that wound up breaking shot-put performances of Mt. Carmel's John Helwig. the Redondo High School track team won the State high school track and field meet at Compton last night with 21 points.

neiwig snattered three records, both with the 12 and 16pound bulbs. He set a new national interscholastic record of 59ft. 5%in., bettering the old mark of 59ft. 11/2 in.; eclipsed the State meet mark of 55ft. 10in. set by Young of Riis High School in 1934 and topped off the evening in a special exhibition by heaving the 16-pound ball 50ft. 9% in. The former best mark recorded by a prep was 46ft. 101/2 in., also by Young in 1934.

Mile Standard Set

The only other meet mark to fall by the wayside was in the mile run which saw Bob Mc-Millen of Cathedral outgun Kohl of Compton in the home stretch to win by six yards in 4m. 24s. This bettered Louis Zamperini's record of 4m. 26.8s., set in 1939 when he was attending Torrance.
