

Salinas.—Fabulous Eddie King did it again!

The sensational Salinas junior ran the fastest quarter mile recorded in the nation yesterday as he paced his teammates to a one-sided victory over the field in the annual CCAL track and field championships held there.

King clipped six-tenths of a second off his previous best to set a new league mark of 48.7. Only last Wednesday, King set a new CCAL mark when he ran 49.3.

Salinas easily won the varsity meet, scoring 107 points to second-place Watsonville's 40 1/4. Santa Cruz finished seventh with a total of nine points.

In the lightweight meet, Watsonville captured the top honors for the second straight year as they were edged by Salinas, 86 3/4 to 65 3/4. The Cardinals finished fifth in the lightweight meet with 16 points.

Santa Cruz' moment of glory came in the lightweight meet when speedy Ed Forbes raced the 1320-yard run in 3:24, three seconds off the previous record set by the same Forbes only three days ago. Forbes was forced to battle off Watsonville's Armand Ardaz in a race to the finish.

Forbes' and King's records were two of eight set during the meet, a ninth was tied.

In other records, Pete Cabanyog of Gonzales lowered the low hurdles mark in the varsity by one-tenth of a second to :20.4. Welch of Salinas ran the 150-yard dash in :15.3, while Salinas bettered both its lightweight and varsity relay records.

The Cowboy varsity ran the 880-relay in 1:32.5, beating its record of last year by three-tenths of a second, while the lightweights knocked three-tenths of a second off its mark of Wednesday with a time of :45.0.

Davis of Salinas set a new discus record when he threw the platter 122' 10 1/4", the old mark was set Wednesday in the trials by Hamblin of Watsonville with a toss of 117' 10".

Little Bobby Fierro again proved he was one of the top pole vaulters in northern California when he set a new record in his varsity event with a leap of 12' 4". The previous best was 12' 1/4".

Santa Cruz' Al Fehn placed fourth in the 800, and was timed at 2:04.4. Bert Bly finished third in the 330, while Tom Silva placed third in the 150-yard dash. Dave York was fourth in the mile, while the lightweight relay team placed fourth.

Howard Adams leaped 11'3" to capture second in the varsity pole vault.

Santa Cruz' efforts were enough to qualify Fehn, York and Adams of the varsity, and Bly, Silva, Forbes and the lightweight relay team for next Saturday's NCS meet at Sunnyvale.

This was the greatest number of men ever qualified from Santa Cruz in the two years Morgan has coached. Morgan thanked his assistant Phil Mooers for his work with the Card distance men.
