

Lincoln Track Aces Set Pace in Trials

SAN JOSE — Lincoln High qualified 10 varsity trackmen and a swift relay team to head the southern Peninsula Athletic League's track trials here yesterday.

The trials, marred by winds which frequently reached better than 30 miles an hour, produced few outstanding marks. Only in the 880 and discus were varsity loop bests approached.

Willow Glen's highly-rated Rams actually led the day's performers by getting 14 qualifiers into the league finals set for Fremont High next Friday night.

The Rams, however, aren't regarded with quite the respect shown Coach Lee Cox's Lions, since the latter placed better quality entrants. Almost all are figured to be among the top three in the circuit, while Willow Glen must be content with fourths and fifths in most events.

Palo Alto, too, must be rated a contender. The Vikes got 10 men in the finals as well as a relay team. Sequoia was next with eight and a baton four-some, while Menlo-Atherton and San Jose each landed four berths.

Don Bowden as usual romped home far ahead of the field in the half mile. The Lincoln flyer's time of 1:57.5 would have been sensational had he not run a 1:54.1 a week ago.

In the platter event, a fine duel for the loop title shaped up between Willow Glen's Walt Swarouth and Palo Alto's Rich Babka. Swarouth whirled the discus out 131-10 to nip Babka by an inch.

Biggest upsets of the day involved Menlo-Atherton aces. Dave Easley, Bear sprinter counted on to break up Lincoln's one-two combination of Bob Knoth and Hank Olguin, showed up with sore feet and failed to finish among the qualifiers.

Coach Don Dorfmeier explained that 10 days ago Easley had run barefoot in a gym class 300 — against explicit orders—

and cut up his feet on the rocky cinder path.

The Bruins gained some measure of revenge, however, as 440-man Ken McKenna upset favored Bob Walrath of Willow Glen. His winning time was :52.6 —about two seconds slower than Walrath is capable of.

The expected mile duel between Paly's Roger Stephens and Lincoln's Marv Gross failed to come off, either. The two rivals chatted amiably as they circled the San Jose High oval, finally loafing home virtually hand in hand in a snail-like 4:54 clocking.

Another upset involved failure of Sequoia's Kermit Walker to make the broad jump finals. He had a best of 18-6 after going unbeaten at better than 20 feet most of the season.

Larry Meade of the Class B Cherokees and Lee Courtwright of Willow Glen each won their heats and appear mighty close in the 150 and 330.

Meade outleaped the varsity broad jumpers with a 20-4½ jump in another B high light.

SPAL Track Trials At San Jose Today

Six schools of the Southern Peninsula Athletic League meet at San Jose High School this afternoon to qualify participants for next week's PAL track finals slated for Fremont High School. The first event of today's trials will start at 3 p.m.

First four finishers in each event except the mile, will qualify for the league finals. Top five men in the mile will answer the gun for the finals.

Both Lincoln and Willow Glen have good chances to cop the PAL meet and will be out to qualify as many men as possible. The Rams should dominate the middle distance races and the field events, while the Lions should have the best of things in the sprints.

The sprints will be the most interesting of the races as several evenly matched men will be battling for berths. Lincoln's

Hank Olguin and Bob Knoth should have little trouble qualifying in the 100, but Sequoia's Roy Pinetti, Palo Alto's John Tynan, Willow Glen's Bob Walrath, and Menlo-Atherton's Dave Easley will make the 220 a rough race to gain a top place. Easley already has run a 22.3 furlong and may be able to beat the two Lion speedsters.

Lincoln's two distance aces Marv Gross and Don Bowden will probably take things easy and save their strength for the finals. Gross will meet Palo Alto's unbeaten Roger Stephens in the mile, but the blond Lion ace plans to lay back and wait a week before he goes after the league record of 4:30.8 set by Lincoln's Fred Frevert in 1944.

San Jose High doesn't figure to frighten anyone in the varsity class, but the Bulldogs should qualify plenty of men in the lightweight divisions. Hurdler Koki Sagara and discus throwers Roy Frontani, Bill Stewart, and Bill DiCristina are the best San Jose varsity entrants.

Willow Glen and Lincoln topped the Southern Peninsula Athletic League meet by qualifying in 13 and nine places respectively yesterday afternoon at San Jose High School.

Lincoln topped the SPAL schools in the unofficial point totals by gaining 41 points to runner-up Willow Glen's 33. Palo Alto was third with 29 markers.

No league records were broken but several outstanding performances were turned in by the competing preps. Lincoln's Don Bowden turned in a 1:57.5 in the halfmile, while Willow Glen's Walt Swarthout, Steve Scott and John Geimer followed in order.

Lincoln's Bob Knoth was the only double winner of the afternoon. The Lion sprinter copped

both sprints in times of 10.3 and 22.2. Teammate Hank Olquin was a close second in both races.

The shot put was where local preps turned in their best performances. Palo Alto's Rinky Babka won with a heave of 48 ft. 11 in., but Lincoln's Don Dirienzo hit 48 ft. 4 in., a whole foot and a half better than his previous best. Willow Glen's Rich Raimondi also turned in a personal best with a toss of 47 ft. 1 in.

Roger Stephens of Palo Alto and Marv Gross of Lincoln battled to a draw in the mile. Both boys were clocked in 4:54 in what seemed to be a planned finish.
