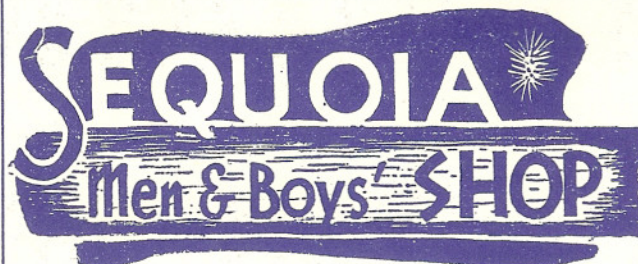

Welcome to the Third Annual Sequoia Invitational Track Meet. Tonight we have another field of well-qualified athletes ready to provide the kind of keen competition you all enjoy witnessing.

The Invitational Committee has worked long and hard to make tonight's meet a success. But there were others who gave a helping hand . . . the Sequoia High School Board of Trustees, Harold Berliner and his staff of AAU officials, Don Bogie, Hi Jennings, A. B. Ingam, and the local advertisers. To these groups and individuals we give our sincere thanks.

Tonight's athletes come from all over the Bay Area and its environs. As you check through our program you'll find boys from as far as Santa Rosa on the north, Carmel on the south, and Modesto on the east. In all, 37 schools are represented.

No one area seems to have a monopoly on talent either. Charles Lagomarsino of Santa Rosa has one of the fastest times this year for the B 1320, while Eddie King of Salinas has the fastest 440-yard time to date in Northern California.
