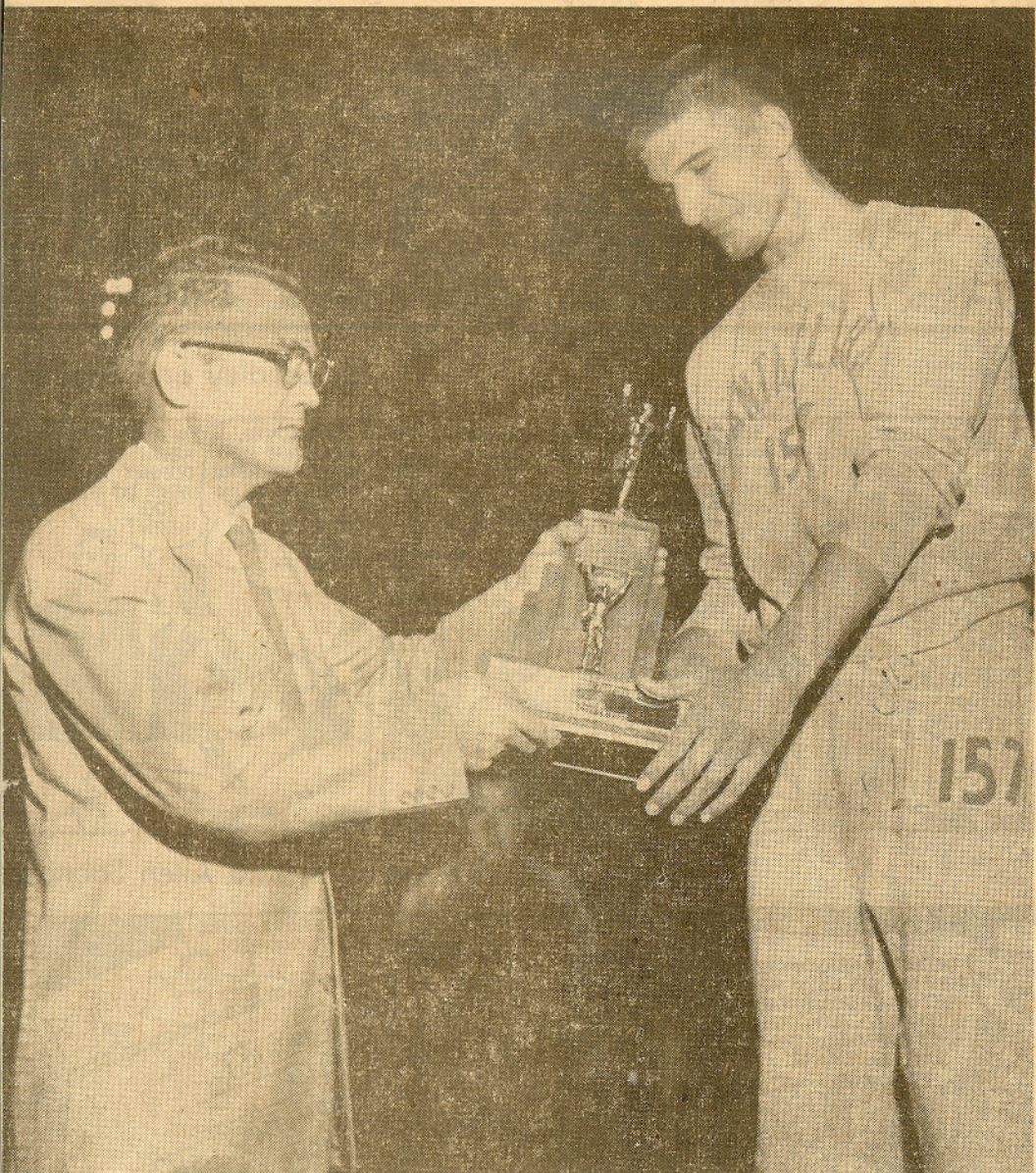

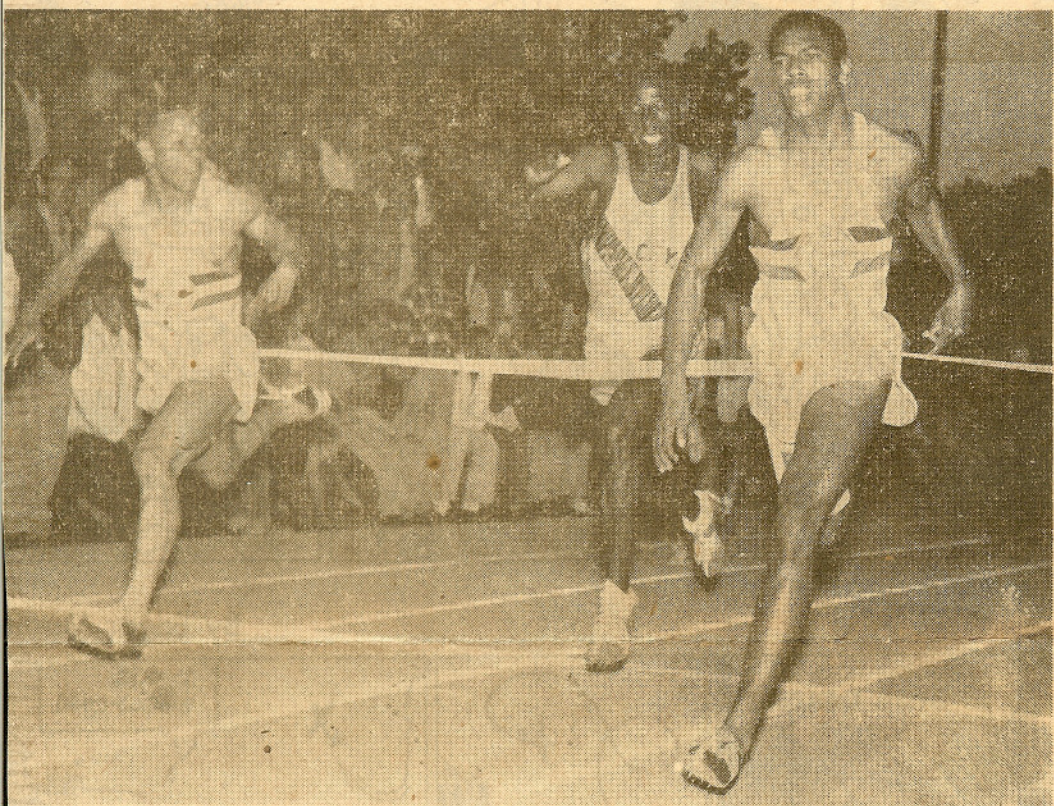

Guilford, James Tops

In NorCal Invitational

**Outstanding Marks in Redwood City Meet;
Kenly, Mattos Clear 14-7; Brewer Misses 14-1**

A high school junior and UCLA sprinter combined to help make the first annual Northern California Invitational Track and Field Meet a success in the eyes of some 1,500 track fans who were present at Sequoia's Terremerre Field Saturday evening.

The prepster, Santa Clara's Larry Guilford, amazed coaches, athletes, officials and fans with a 14.6 victory in the high hurdles after running a 14.9 preliminary heat, the first time he had ever been over the college height (42 inches) hurdles.

Later, he came back to finish second in his first crack at the 220 lows, running a respectable 23.9, and he broad jumped 21-9 $\frac{1}{4}$ for second there.

For his efforts, Guilford was presented with the Tribune's outstanding performer trophy, barely edging collegian Dave James of UCLA.

James, representing the Southern California Striders, edged teammate Ken Dennis and the Santa Clara County Youth Center's Len Noles in a 9.6 100, good in any man's language and excellent considering the soft track.

He came back to place a close second in the 220 behind Noles, who won in 21.1, and became an added entry in the 220-yard low hurdles 15 minutes later, winning in 23.7.

The sprints and hurdles were not the only outstanding events, however, as the pole vault, discus and javelin also produced fine marks.

Although Jim Brewer, the high school vault sensation from North Phoenix High School in Arizona had his first bad day this year and could clear "only" 13-7, far short of his best of 15-0 $\frac{1}{8}$, the Striders' Dave Kenly and the Youth Center's two-time Olympian George Mattos thrilled the crowd with 14-7 performances.

Rink Babka, the former Palo Alto prep weightman, now attending the University of Southern California, topped a good discus field with a heave of 172-2 $\frac{3}{4}$, topping teammate Jack Egan (168-5 $\frac{1}{2}$), Mike Lewis of Lincoln High School of San Francisco (150-3) and Tom Strong of Menlo-Atherton (149-6 $\frac{1}{8}$).

The javelin field was led by the Olympic Club's Les Bitner, who got off his best heave of the season, 234-6, followed by Teammate Leo Long at 221-1 $\frac{1}{4}$.

The mile and the half-mile runs did not produce the times expected of them as runners jockeyed for position, the better ones not wishing to set the pace.

Norman Lloyd, Stanford's import, took the mile in 4:22.5, taking the lead and running away from San Jose State's Ken Napier in the final 50 yards.

The half went to another foreign ace, Fred Montour of Canada, who ran for College of San Mateo this year. Mon-

tour was clocked in 1:55.2 in edging Sacramento State's Stan Cole. Tom Anderson of USC was a last minute scratch due to transportation problems which also sidelined the Trojan's national frosh shot-put record holder Dave Davis.

Wil Gasper of City College of San Francisco took the high jump at 6-3 $\frac{1}{4}$.

In the two most grueling races of the day, College of Pacific's Jack Marden captured the 10,000-meter run, in 36:13.3, edging James Lick prepster Dave Buckland by two seconds, and Walt Boehm of the Olympic Club captured the 5,000 in 15:29.0.

A comparatively slow quarter mile went to former St. Ignatius prep ace now at Georgetown University Carlos Tan in 49.8.

Big John Kahner of the Olympic Club won as expected in the shot at 52-9 $\frac{3}{4}$.

Stanford's Kent Hansen took the hop, step and jump at 43-3 $\frac{1}{8}$, while former Yale jumper Tod Lewis, now with the Winged O, took the broad jump at 22-10 $\frac{1}{4}$, although forced to drop out early in the completion with a pulled muscle.

Cubberley prep ace Dave Kilbourne won with ease in his first crack at the 440 hurdles in 57.6 when ex-Sequoia Jim Luttrell, the favorite, was unable to attend the meet.

Another premeet casualty was Irish sprinter Dorothy Lloyd, who sat out on doctor's orders, allowing PFC Gloria Griffin of the Marines to win the women's 100 without a strain in 12.0.

An all-star high school mile relay team topped San Francisco's Riordan in a respectable 3:25.2.

Ken Benscoter of Chowchilla High School ran away from the field in the special prep mile run in 4:29.6.

Cosponsored by the Northern California Track and Field Association and the Redwood City Recreation Department, the meet was underwritten by the Peninsula Celebrations Association.

Ibbotson Turns 3:58.4

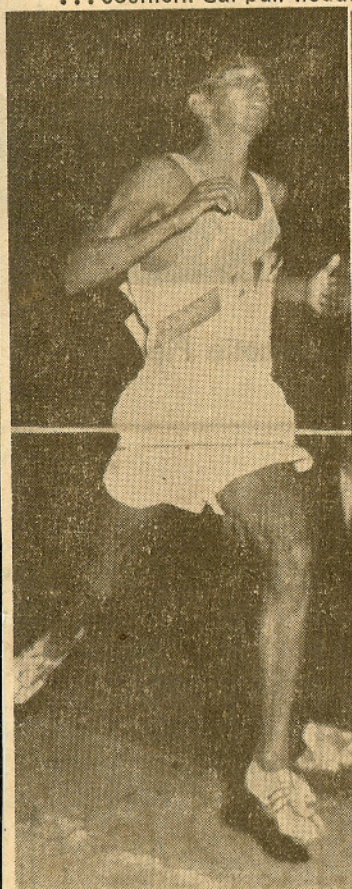
GLASGOW, Scotland (AP)—England's Derek Ibbotson ran the second fastest mile with a 3:58.4 clocking Saturday.

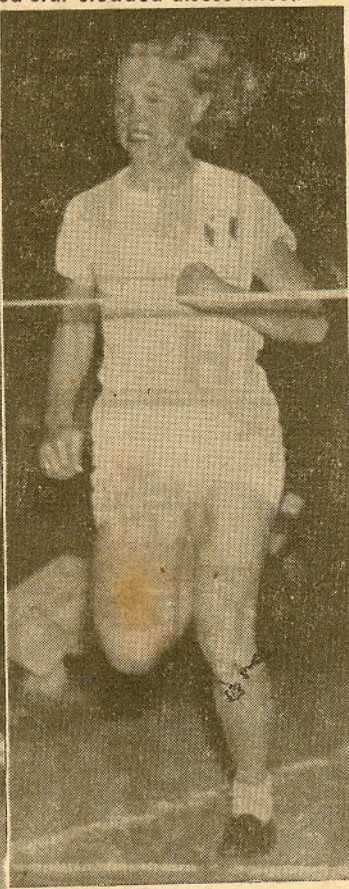

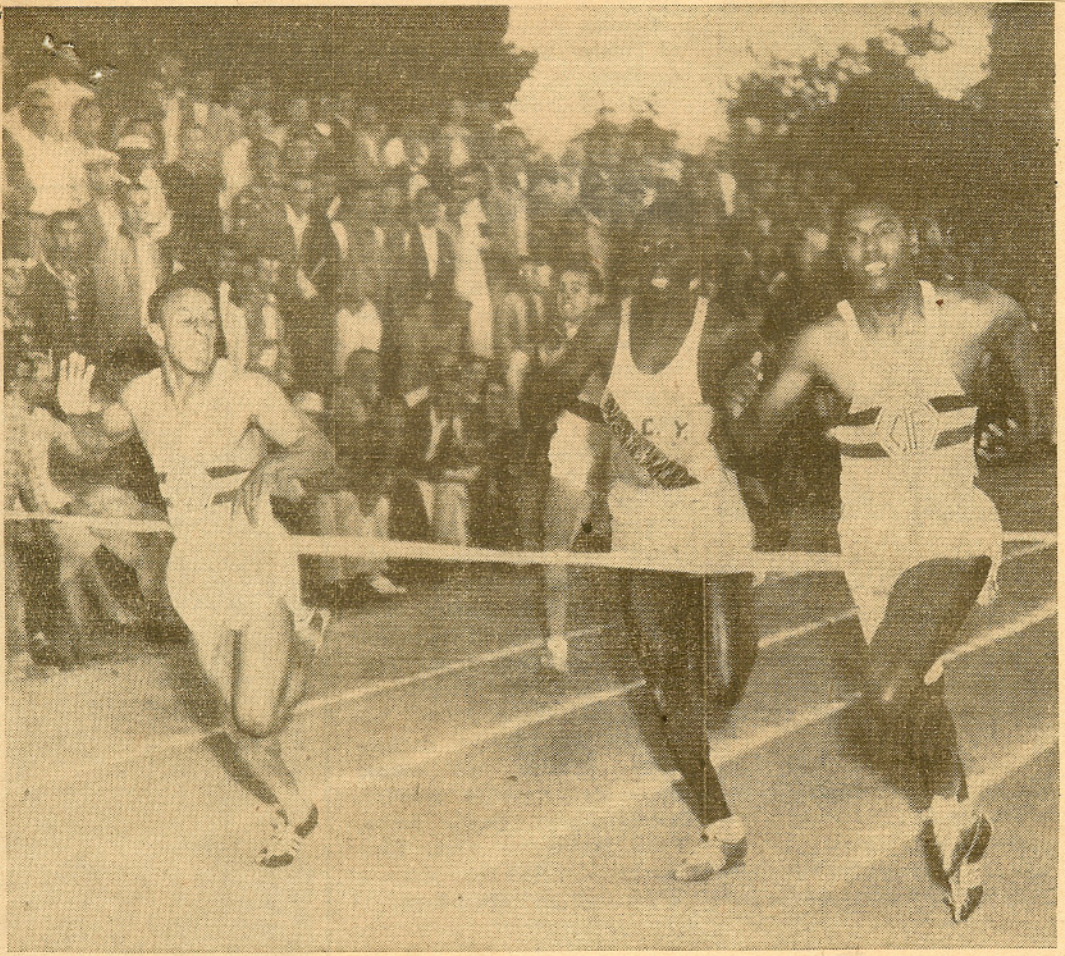

Prep Guilford Outstanding In AAU Track

Big league track has come to the Peninsula today as a result of the pioneering efforts of the Northern California Track and Field association.

The Peninsula group's initial venture in meet promotion was being judged a success in just about every respect, following Saturday's Northern California and individual meet at Sequoia High school in Redwood City.

Only disappointing feature of the packed, yet smoothly run program was the crowd size. An estimated 1800 fans enjoyed the competition of the state's top performance under ideal weather conditions. Meet officials hoped for a crowd of 3000.

The Invitational touches off a series of weekly all-comers meets planned by the NCTFA. Beginning next Saturday, the group will sponsor nine all-comer meets at Terremere field during the summer months.

While college and club athletes turned in most of the evening's outstanding marks, it was an unheralded high school junior who walked off with the Outstanding Performer trophy.

Larry Quilford, a three-sport athlete at Santa Clara High school, won the vote of meet officials and sports writers in a close ballot with David James of the Southern California Striders.

'OUTSTANDING PERFORMER' SJ MERCURY Guilford Features Redwood City Meet

REDWOOD CITY — Larry Guilford, Santa Clara High School's brilliant hurdler-broad jumper, outshined the collegiate and open division athletes to win "Outstanding Performer" award at the Redwood City Invitational Track and Field meet here Saturday night.

Guilford, a junior at the Mission City school, won the 120-yard high hurdles in a speedy :14.6, and took second in the 220-low hurdles (:23.9) and the broad jump at 21-9 1/4. It was Guilford's first competition in the 42-inch high barriers and the longer distance low timbers. His best over the 39-inch high hurdles was :14.7.

Guilford, who was named by a poll of sportswriters and officials, won by a narrow margin over David James, winner of the 100-yard dash and low hurdles, and second place finisher in the 220.

Other outstanding marks were a 14-6 tie for first in the pole vault between George Mattos of the Santa Clara County Youth Center and Dave Kenley of the Southern Cal Striders; James' :09.6 in the 100, and a 172 3/4 duscus throw by Rink Babka, USC.

James was the only double winner in the meet, which was witnessed by 1800 fans on the windless Sequoia High School oval. Several top entrants were forced to withdraw prior to the meet for various reasons. These include halm-miler Tom Anderson, javeline thrower Bob Voiles and shot putter Dave Davis of USC; Lang Stanley, Striders; and high jumpers Vern Wilson and Herm Wyatt of the Youth Center.

Jim Brewer, 15-0 prep vaulter

from North Phoenix, Ariz., failed to clear 14-0, for one of the few times this season. He tied for third with Bill Flint of the Olympic Club at 13-7.
