

M-A qualifies

14 runners

for meet finals

Menlo-Atherton High School took a step toward the Sequoia district track and field championship by qualifying 14 runners for Saturday night's finals at Redwood City.

But it was a slender senior from Sequoia who turned in the best performances of the trials at Sequoia High School yesterday. John Miller topped qualifiers in the 100-yard dash with a 10 flat clocking.

Miller also led in the 220-yard dash with a 22.3 win in his heat. The race was run around one turn.

JIM CHEATHAM, Stu Hawley, Willie Waller, Jon Peck and Dick Burns each qualified in two events for M-A.

Hawley turned in the best time in the 440-yard dash with 52.0. Jerry Varty of M-A topped high hurdlers in both heats in 16.7. Burns was fastest in the low hurdles with a 20.9 clocking.

Lefty Jarrett of Ravenswood and Henry McGurie of Woodside were the standouts among B qualifiers. McGurie won the 330-yard dash in 36.6 and took a place in the 75-yard dash with 8.0.

Jarrett led low hurdles qualifiers by zipping over 120 yards in 13.8.
