

FREMONT — Washington's Huskies proved to be the rude host in Friday night's SCVAL-East track and field championships by winning all but six events and coasting to the team championship.

Coach Jim Sperou's charges accumulated 88 1/2 points to runnerup Lincoln's 36. Willow Glen was defending titlist and finished sixth.

Russ Pierce was a triple winner for the Huskies and successfully defended his crowns won last year in each event. He led the 100 in 10.2, the 220 in 22.0 and won the hop-step-jump 41.7.

Another defending titlist was Jim Pinson of Willow Glen who set a meet record in the shot put with a 58-8 3/4 mark which he established in Tuesday's trials. The Ram strongman lost his discus title to teammate John Cali, who tossed 159-3 to break the 156-10 1/2 mark set in 1959 by Washington's Dave Nickel.
