This Twenty-Fifth, Silver-Anniversary edition of the HELMS ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA HIGH SCHOOL TRACK and FIELD RECORD BOOK, covering the season of 1961, is respectfully dedicated to MANNIE PINEDA, who has served as a member of All-Southern California Board of Athletics for a period of fifteen eventful years, 1947-1961.

MANNIE PINEDA has been a most capable sports journalist for most of his adult life. Except for time out to serve the U.S. Army, and well, during World War II, Mannie was sports journalist for the Pasadena Star-News from 1930 through 1960, and is now affiliated with the Los Angeles Mirror-News, having taken over duties for this major newspaper early in 1961.

Pineda's fast-moving Pasadena Star-News column, Sportingly Yours, was widely read, and it was a feature of the publication.

Born at Via de Santa Barbara, Chihuahua, Mexico on October 28, 1908, Mannie Pineda attended Pasadena High School, and Pasadena City College, where he excelled in athletics. During World War II, Pineda saw overseas duty with the 3RD Army, 26TH Division, 101ST Infantry, which endured the Battle of the Bulge.

A member of All-Southern California Board of Athletics since 1947, Mannie Pineda has contributed much to High School athletics in Southern California through his journalistic efforts and his generous devotion to Board activities.

This marks the 25th year that Helms Athletic Foundation has issued its Southern California Track and Field Record Book in the interest of high school athletics. It lists outstanding performances and records established by Southland high school track and field performers during the 1961 season. Five hundred record books are distributed by Helms Athletic Foundation each season without charge. Books are sent to coaches at high schools, colleges and universities throughout the country and to press, radio and television commentators, plus athletic coaches and officials.

Material gathered in this booklet has been obtained from sources believed to be reliable. Information has been provided by high school coaches, sports editors of student newspapers, as well as from the sports pages of southland newspapers.

This 25th annual Track and Field Record Book contains best marks of Los Angeles City and CIF track and field athletes over past years, past City and CIF championship teams and present City, State and National Interscholastic records. The book contains sections on top meets of the year, results of Southern California's four big prep meets of the year, best all-time marks by Southern California prep athletes and many other interesting sections.

Helms Athletic Foundation, with offices at Helms Hall, Los Angeles, is sponsored by Paul H. Helms, Jr. The Foundation was established in 1936, with one of its main functions that of recording the achievements of athletes in all sports and in all divisions.

Track and Field Athletes of the Year are also listed for both Los Angeles City and CIF, selections which have been made by All-Southern California Board of Athletics since 1937.

Track & Field athletes selected for Athlete of the Year honors since 1937, have their names engraved upon the Paul H. Helms Perpetual Trophy which is permanently lodged in Helms Hall, Los Angeles.

Southern California High School Track & Field Record Books are on file at Helms Hall and available for research purposes.

Three record-breaking track and field performers from the southland prep ranks were named outstanding athletes for 1961, when members of the Helms All-Southern California Board of Track & Field made their annual thinclad selections following the close of the season. All three boys -- Vern Williams (San Pedro), Ulis Williams (Compton) and Forrest Beaty (Glendale Hoover)-- broke existing city and CIF records this season.

San Pedro's Vern Williams won the pole vault in the Los Angeles City Championships, setting a new meet record of 13' 8 3/4". Vern tied for second in the State Meet with a vault of 13' 10". San Pedro High School's track and field team was coached by Robert Stegmiller in 1961.

The Southern California co-athletes of the year in track and field both set National Interscholastic records during the season. Forrest Beaty, of Glendale Hoover, set a national mark in the CIF Southern Section finals with a 220-yard mark of 20.2. Beaty was on the 1960 track and field team in the 220, having a best time of 21.1 seconds. Beaty was also the Helms Board's choice in the 100-yard event, as he won the CIF Southern Section 100-yard event. His best time for the century was 9.5 seconds. Beaty's coaches were Sam Nicholson and Dave Herman.

Ulis Williams, Compton High's great 440-yard runner, was named for honors in recognition of his national record in the quarter mile. Ulis ran a 46.1 to set his national record in the CIF Southern Section Championships and also won the State 440 crown in 47.8. Beaty was also a double winner in both CIF and State meets.

Williams was coached by the long-time thinclad instructor at Compton High School Ernst Hartmann.
