

# Runners steal the show

For the first time this season, the track men were the stars for Los Altos High School.

Hurdler Bob Feero, sprinter Walt Lamb, half-miler Bob Tom Burton and miler Paul Graham were the stars for the Knights who racked up a record 106½ points to win the North Santa Clara Valley Athletic League championship for the fifth straight year.

Feero ran the high hurdles in 14.6 and also took the lows. Lamb came up with his best race of the year in winning the 100-yard dash in 9.9.

Burton's time of 1:58.1 is one of the best in Northern California this season.

Graham and freshman Mike Ryan of Wilcox High School in Santa Clara staged a torrid race in the mile.

Graham won in 4:25.2 but Ryan, son of Santa Clara Youth Village coach Mike Ryan, was second in 4:26.6.

That betters the national record of 4:30.7.

The big news in the field events was made by Tyler Wilkins of Mountain View High School and Tim Moran of Sunnyvale. Wilkins handed Bob Stoecker of Los Altos his first defeat of the season in the discus.

Wilkins threw 181-10¼ for his best mark of the season.

Moran won the broad jump in 22-9 which is a league best for the season.

Randy Schnider of Los Altos took the shot put at 60-6½.

The top three placers in all events qualify for the SCVAL finals at Fremont High School next Friday.

East and West winners also will compete in the meet.

Fremont won the Class B title and Sunnyvale won in Class C and Class D.


