

Carlmont wins track crown

Carlmont High School scored an easy team win in the annual Sequoia district track meet at Sequoia High School Friday night.

The Scots scored 102 1-6 points to 46½ for second place San Carlos.

Top marks in the varsity competition were by Harry Cross of San Carlos in the 880-yard run and Lynn Arnesen of Carlmont in the pole vault.

Cross set a meet record of 1:58.3 and Arnesen set a record with a vault of 12-5¾.

In the Class B meet Brian Hea of Woodside was a double winner. The best mark was a 21-8 broad jump by Irvin Eley of Ravenswood to upset favored teammate Bobby Washington.

In Class C Pete Pardee was a double winner for Woodside as the Wildcats won with 61 points.
