Terra Nova Takes NPL Relay Meet

Terra Nova High school won the final event—the 880-yard relay—to beat out Westmoor High school for the North Peninsula league's first annual relays championship at Westmoor yesterday.

Terra Nova posted 59 points to the Rams' 56, followed by South San Francisco with 43, Jefferson with 33, Oceana with 11 and El Camino with eight.

Jefferson won the class B division with 55 points, and Westmoor took the class C division with 50 points.

North Peninsula Oval 'Sweep' by Westmoor?

Westmoor's Rams have aspirations for a "clean sweep" in North Peninsula League track-and-field this season.

That's the outlook after the NPL relays, where Kent Herkenrath's Rams placed a close second in varsity and Class B competition, and won Class C "hurrying and huffing." Dual meet action begins Friday.

Terra Nova's fog-bound Tigers managed a 59-51 win over Westmoor's varsity and it was closer than the scorecard showed. The Rams and Tigers were tied 51-51 going into the 880 relay, final meet event at Westmoor's oval.

TERRA NOVA won the crucial 880 for NPL varsity honors, with a Westmoor disqualification costing the Rams' five points. Otherwise the final tally would have been 59-56 for Dennis Lanterman's Terra Nova spikers.

South SF will field a strong varsity team, but offers little in Class B or C. Tony Fardella's varsity Warriors totaled

46 points in the relays, five behind Westmoor. In Bs SSF placed sixth and in Cs, fifth.

Bob Lualhati's Jefferson Indians took Class B honors, downing Westmoor, 57-45, with Terra Nova third at 36. Westmoor's 50 1/3 points netted first place in C's, with Jeff 8 1/2 points behind.

Terra Nova's varsity win came by the speedy feet of Tiger runners, as Lanterman's lads won all running events except one. Westmoor proved best in field events, winning the pole vault but losing the high and broad jumps by six inches total—which cost the Rams a varsity first.

Fardella's Warriors seized the varsity high jump, shot, discus, and hurdles.

JEFF'S B'S win came through nifty efforts in the hurdles, sprints, shot, and BJ. Terra Nova won the 440 with a :48 clocking, but finished weak in the field, where Westmoor won the discus by 25 feet total. Oceana's pole-vault aggregate (29-6) was the same as the

varsity winning total.

Herkenrath's Ram C's took the shot (by 19 feet), pole, hurdles, and 1 1/2 mile relay.
