

Carlmont wins district track meet

Carlmont broke the Sequoia District Track and Field Meet record as the Scots ran up 117 points to top the 103 they set last year, Friday night at Sequoia.

Carlmont completely dominated the night by scoring in all but three events. Woodside finished second with 43½ points and Menlo-Atherton was third with 39.

Jack Sandin was the first winner of the night for the Scots. He did 1:58.8 in the 880. Andy Sears won the 100 in 9.9, Roger Royal took the 440 in 50.8 and Gary Larsen finished first in the two mile at 10:07.1, before Steve Crosby of Woodside stopped the Carlmont win streak, winning the 180 low hurdles in 20.1.

The best time of the night was

by Mike McCann of Carlmont in the mile. McCann led from the start and finished in 4:25.9.

Ravenswood's Don Brown, Tom Grimm and Gary Phillips of Carlmont turned in the best field marks. Brown leaped 6-3 to break the district high jump mark of 6-0¼, while Grimm hurled the discus 164-10 to break the old meet record of 161-2. Phillips broke the pole vault record by six inches.

The best race was the varsity relay. Carlmont, the favorite, led for the first 440, but a bad hand-off gave Ravenswood the lead. Carlmont fell to fourth, but Royal pulled them back to second as he gave the baton to Sandin. Sandin passed Willie Webster of Ravenswood 150 yards from the finish. Then out

of fourth place came M-A's Bert Werden. The Bear, flashed past the leaders in the last 50 yards to win by six feet.

Carlmont (Who Else) Wins Title

It's the same old story today as it was six years ago and for every year since — Carlmont High School is the winner of the annual Sequoia District track and field championships.

The Scots showed more power than in any of the previous meets last night, however, as they rolled up a record 117 points. The closest competition came from Woodside, who tallied 43½ points.

San Carlos ran up 99 points to outdistance Sequoia in the Class B competition, while the Cherokees turned the tides on the Dons to win the Class C meeting.

The cold night, attended by few under the lights at Terremere field, may have been a costly one for Coach Loren Lansberry's Scots. Star sprinter, Andy Sears, after winning the 100 in :09.9, pulled up after 110 yards in the 220. The star senior complained of a tightness in his leg. Lansberry is hoping that the injury will not keep Sears out of next week's SPAL finals.

Despite his injury, Sears was voted the most outstanding track award, while teammate Tom Grimm, who won the discus in a meet record 164-10, was named as the top field performer.

Meet records were few as the athletes could not perform at top peak in the cold weather.

Carlmont's Jack Sandin won the 880 in 1:58.8, his second best mark of the year, while Roger Royal copped the 440 in :50.8, and Mike McCann ran a 4:25.9 mile. Dennis Phillips set a meet mark in the pole vault with a 13-0 leap.

San Carlos' Terry Evans won both hurdles. Terry Kane the 1320 and John Lilly the 330 to lead the Don B's victory.
