....Trackmen Head for Nevada....

Sacramento State College, sporting a 2-0 dual meet record, takes its unbeaten track and field team to Meno, for a triangular meet with Sonoma State College and the University of Nevada, on Saturday.

According to coach Harvey Roloff, "this meet will feature a track versus field events, since SSC is very strong in the sprints and long distances, while Nevada has some of the strongest field men in the NCAA."

Dick Dankworth's Wolfpack features three outstanding performers, all Far Western Conference Record holders. Among this group are Bob Rautio, who has thrown the javelin 240°5°, Bill Perry, who has ran the intermediate hurdles in 52.2, and discus man George Price, whose best effort is 197°6°. Also expected to show well for Nevada are FWC 1966 shot put champion Howard Briles (57°6°), and 120 yard high hurdless Vic Simmons, who qualified for the NCAA finals with a time of 14.2 last season.

Along with their strong hhO and mile relay teams, Sacramento State will also feature some fine athletes. Yesterday in an intra squad meet, Larry Fox and Lee Ferrero both broke the school mark for the two-mile run with times of 9:21.0 and 9:21.5 respectively. The sprints will be in good hands with Charles Gary and Robert Prince expected to run one-two in the 100 and 220 yard dashes.

In the 800, Darryl Wilson and Tom Paine have been looking good with times of 1:56.8 and 1:57.5. Rich Harris and Al Mello have been impressive in the 440 yard dash with marks of 49.1 and 48.8.

The feature race of the meet should be in the intermediate hurdles, where Dick Reimers (53.1) and Bill Perry (52.2) should set a new FWC record.

Physically, SSC has been hampered by the losses of Manfred Korge, and Charles Bell, both sprinters, along with top field performer Kenny Good, who may possibly be ready for action.
