Madera First At King City

King City — Madera High took top honors in this year's edition of the annual King City Invitational track meet held here yesterday.

The lightweight crown came into the hands of Westmoor. Watsonville placed third and Soquel fourth in that division. Watsonville also was second in varsity competition with Santa Cruz tied for seventh.

Santa Cruz High's Byron Wilson tied the meet's record in the 220-yard dash as he hit the tape in 21.3 seconds to match the old clocking of John Johnson of Pacific Grove in 1964.

Wilson could have been the top man in the century run but a quick start put him almost three steps behind the main opposition at the start.

Steve Johnson set a new Watsonville High record in the high jump as he cleared the bar at 6'3". Dennis McCoulough of San Lorenzo Valley took fourth place in the competition as he went over at 5'11".

Roy Hooten of the Soquel lightweight took a second in the lightweight pole vault competi-

tion as he finished at a height of 10'3".

Ken Gregory set a new Santa Cruz lightweight discus record which had been standing since 1938 as he tossed the platter 120'2" in the Cardinals meet captured the runner up slot in Thursday. He placed high in both the shot put and discus here today.

Marvin White of the Soquel lightweight team placed second in the 100 yard dash and also the high jump in which Hooten took a third.

Madera captured the 880 yard relay as they completely outdid their opposition in all four legs of the race, setting a new meet record of 1:30.8.

Varsity team scores were Madera 31, Watsonville 30, Seaside, 18, Monterey and King City 15, Overfelt 14, Paso Robles and Santa Cruz 13, Pioneer 11, Alisal 9, Westmoor 8, Carmel and Gilroy 6, Gonzales, Atascadero and Pacific Grove 4, El Camino 3, Palma, Mt. Pleasant, San Lorenzo Valley and North Salinas 1.

Westmoor won the "B" division with 33 points. Other placers by points included Santa Clara 21½, Watsonville 16, Soquel 15, Atascadero 12, Madera, Overfelt and Pioneer 11, Jefferson 9, Gilroy and Morro Bay 8½, Mt. Pleasant, Salinas and El Camino 8, King City and Alisal 7, Seaside 6, Palma 4, Gonzales 3, and North Salinas and Oceana 1.
