Marcus Stars for UCLA; Railsback Breaks Hand

Steve Marcus took six puts Saturday and broke the UCLA school shot put record on every one of them.

The 280-pound junior from Pacific Palisades finished with a 62-2¼ mark which wiped out Traugott Gloeckler's two-year old record of 60-3½.

Marcus' effort was one of 16 UCLA victories in 17 events in a 120-25 rout of San Diego State in the year's opening outdoor meet at Trotter Track. His six-put series was 61-5½, 61-8 ¾, 62-2 ¼, 61-9½, 60-10½ and 60-9 ¼. Marcus' best previous outdoor mark was 59-9½.

The good news over Marcus' remarkable improvement was dulled, however, by an injury to Dick Railsback, the Bruins' 17-foot pole vaulter.

Railsback suffered a broken bone in his left hand when his pole broke while he was attempting 15-6. Doctors said the shock of the pole snapping caused the bone to break. It was estimated Railsback's hand would be in a cast three to four weeks.

Johnny Johnson, who came to UCLA with a reputation as a long jumper, not only won his specialty at 24-7 ¾, but also upset Hal Busby with a 9.6 100 yard dash.

Another newcomer, Russ Hodge, entered four events and scored in them all. He was second in the shot (58-3 ¼), third in

the 100 (9.8), third in the discus (162-10) and ran on the winning 440 relay team.
