tors and spectators.

Medals were issued to the top five placers of each event in each division, but as one coach remarked, "Awards should have been issued to each person who survived the blistering winds and bitter cold."

team titles. South San Francisco finished first with 84 points in varsity

competition, but on the strength of its six dual-meet victories the Rams eked out the champion-

ship.

The Rams also won the C division title behind the tremendous triple win of sophomore Scott Heaton. Jefferson's mile relay quartet of Pete Michon, Bill McCollum, Don Redmon and

Ron Venezia edged Westmoor to protect its narrow victory over El Camino for the B crown. SSF's varsity garnered seven first places, highlighted by double winners Russ Cottrell

double winners Russ Cottrell and Ashland Whitfield.

Cottrell won the 100 yard dash in a wind-aided 9.8 and it appeared that he slowed slightly before reaching the tape. Cottrell easily won the 220 in 23.6, a good time considering runners were confronted with a gust of wind going into the turn.

Whitfield bettered his own

Whitfield bettered his own NPL record of 19.5 in the low hurdles, but the wind was at his back so his 19.4 clocking will not

count as a league mark.

Whitfield nipped Westmoor's Mike Clabby in both the high and low hurdles. Whitfield's high hurdles time of 14.8 was one-tenth second off his record clocking of 14.7 set in the trials. In an exciting mile run, El Camino's Ric Cano and Oceana's Randy Duckett each bettered the former NPL record of 4:34.5 held by Terra Nova's Bill Hernandez.

nandez. Cano and Duckett exchanged the lead several times before Cano streaked ahead with 440 yards left to win at 4:28.9. Duckett was clocked at 4:33.0.
