COLUMBUS, O., Apr. 19-- Despite unbelievably bad weather conditions, three meet records toppled today in the Ohio State Relays, with Pitt's Jerry Richey recording the most notable performance when he won the three-mile run in 13:57.9.

All trial heats, and half of the finals were conducted in a sleet sterm, a driving north wind and temperatures ranging from 33 to 37 degrees. Hurdles and dashes were run against winds mmm of from 18 to 25 miles an hour.

Richey, and sophomore Sid Sink of Bowling Green State both bettered the old meet mark of 14,02.3 by Dick Sharkey of Michigan State in 1964.

Richey followed a 4:46 and 9:42 pace by Ohio U.'s Bob Bertelsen, Aueling Sink and in the final mile principally with Dave Ellis, Min Eastern Michigan's

Canadian Odympian. Ellis suffered a hard fall at 1 3/4 miles, but recovered to regain the lead briefly until Richey pulled away in the last 300 yards.

Sink's 14:01.6 also was under Sharkey's meet record.

The other meet recorded that fell man to Indiana's 440 relay team of Mike Godrich, Ken Lundgren, Jim Ricks and Larry Highbaugh. They snipped a tenth off Tennessee's 1967 time of 41.1.

So atrocious were the weather that only 15 of the 30 pole wault entries elected to compete, and only three made the starting height of 13-6. Mel Miller of Toledo won at 14 ft., and Les Smith of Miami, the NCAA indoor champion, had to settle for a 13-6 tie with Terry Green of Ohio State. It as worth noting that Gary Manne Haupert of Indiana, a 7-ft. high jumper indoors, cleared only 6-4.

Lowell Paul, the Chicago Track Club's top middle distance man, achieved a double. He successfully defended his 880 title in 1:53.1 after nailing the mile in 4:18.4.

Herb Washington, swift Mi Michigan State freshman, cut through the grain to win the 100 in 9.7, easily, from Goodrich. Of the eight finalists, two scratched and two others pulled up without finishing the course. Another good performance under the conditions was the 3:16.6 mile relay wan by Middle Tennessee State's Cary Scott, Dennis Dandy, Dave Wyatt and Jerry Singleton.


