

CUNNINGHAM STARS - 20 NEW MEET RECORDS SET

SANTA MARIA-- Tyrone Cunningham, an airman from Vandenberg Air Force Base, won four first places and one second to high-light the first Winter All-Comer Meet at Allan Hancock College.

In all, twenty new meet records were set; 9 in the open division and 11 in the high school class. Wayne Barbee of Cal-Poly accounted for two of the new marks when he sailed the discus 137 feet 5 inches and hurled the hammer 157 feet 8 inches.

Other new records were set by; Ray Manning of AHC in the 440 with a time of 51.4, in the mile by Jeff James of Cal-Poly with a time of 4:30.1, in the triple jump by Maurica Peoples of Hancock with a leap of 45 feet 9 inches, by Cunningham in the long jump at 23 feet 2 inches, in the shot put by Junior Olson of the Mustangs with a toss of 50 feet $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches, in the pole vault by Mark Deitchman at 13 feet $3\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch, and in the mile relay with the Cal-Poly team of James, Tony Mitchell, David Bronzan, and Gary DuVal with a time of 3:35.0. Bronzan also set a new two mile record with a clocking of 9:47.7.

In the high school competition, Charlie Jackson of Lompoc was the big gun as he won the 100, 70 high hurdles, ~~long jump~~ and triple jump. Jackson set new meet records in all three events. His team mate, John Ward, also accounted for two new records as he captured both weight events.

Other record setters were; Dale Brickner of Lompoc with a ~~24~~ 23.7 in the 220, Terry Evans of Lompoc with a time of 2:04.0 in the 880, Buddy Kring with a leap of 5 feet $11\frac{1}{4}$ inches in the high jump, Timmy Sanford of Santa Maria with a time of 15:03.0 in the three mile run, the mile relay of Harvey, Evans, Evans, and Eiles of Lompoc in 3:41.0, and the pole vault of 13 feet $6\frac{3}{4}$ inches by Santa Maria's Kenny Kring.

Marks were considered quite outstanding for this time of year and much improvement is expected over the next few weeks.

Second meet of the Winter will be held next Saturday, December 13th at Allan Hancock College with the first event starting at 12:00 noon.
