

competitor a thinking man would never bet against, stole from Stanford one of only three "cinch firsts" the Indians had counted on when he out-kicked the favorite, Duncan McDonald, down the stretch to win in 4:05.6.

The crowd had been primed for that drama by the previous two running events — both meet records.

Stanford's Brook Thomas set the first of the day's four meet records when he ran an all but unopposed 9:12.4 in the 3000-meter steeplechase. The second placer, Stanford's Chuck Menz, clocked 9:31.8.

Cal's 440 relay squad, seeing that tough competition was not a criterion for outstanding marks, then set the new one-lap relay meet mark at 40.0, when anchorman Ed Hart crossed the finish some 21 yards in the lead.

Blanket Finish

Isaac Curtis led a blanket finish in the 100 for Cal, with he, Hart and Dave Masters each getting a 9.6. Masters later equalled the meet record in the 220 at 21.2 with Hart taking second and Curtis third.

Cal's Roddy Lee won both the 120 high and the 440 intermediate hurdles in photo finishes. In the shorter race he outleaned teammate Kerry Hampton as both were timed in 14.3, and in the other he got the nod over Stanford's Randy White while both were clocked at 52.3.

There was even something for collectors of strange results at The Big Meet, 1970. The pole vault was won with a meager 14-6 effort by Stanford's Scott Stillinger. That winning mark would have been better but the only man who could have made it so, Stanford's Casey Carrigan, pulled up lame in practice.

Even more of an oddity was the new meet record in the triple jump, a 50-8³/₄ leap by Cal's Rich Dunn. He only took second place since Stanford's Allen Meredith three-stepped 50-9¹/₂. Meredith, a former Cal man, did not get the meet record since his leap was wind aided.
