WINZENRIED S QUARTER TIMES FOR HIS GREAT RUN WERE 60. 61, 62, AND 58.9 SECONDS, RESPECTIVELY WHILE VANDREY, WHO LED THE FIRST THREE QUARTERS OF THE RADE WAS CAUGHT IN SPLETS OF 59, 61.2, 60.8 AND 63.3 SECONDS, RESPECTIVELY.
