TRACK BY-LAWS

Revised to April 1, 1969

The following revisions in track by-laws should be added to the B-7 section of said by-laws. A complete revision will be made later as the track committee will have to recommend new prodedures under the recently adopted change making four sectins in all sports.

- 1. Meet Rotation1969-Region I, SPAL, Carlmont HIgh host at CSM-Director Andy Darby, May 31
 1970-Region II, May 30.
 1971-Region III, May 29
- 2. Region Committee-This shall be composed of one coach from each league and the League Commissioners. Besides seeing that a sight and director have been chosen for the Region Meet, the committee will recommend to the Section Track Committeea Meet Director and the best possible sight for holding the Section Meet when it is due to be held in that particular Region.
- 3. Unattached Participation The school name or emblem shall not appear on any item of equipment or clothing worn by any participant.participating una tached.
- 4. Awards-Add to the first sentence in the present by-laws under AWARDS the words "in both divisions".

 Region Meet participants taking the first five places in each event will receive medals instead of ribbons-effective 1970.
- 5. Order of Field Events-Varsity shot, Long jump, High Jump, Class triple jump, Discuss throw, Pole vault, and reverse for the second round.
- 6. Qualification of Athletes-For the purpose of qualifying athletes, All-Male Schools will be counted on a basis of double their male enrolments.
- 7. Frosh-Soph events will be the same as those now used in the Class B division, effective 1970.
