Los Altos Ace Steals Show in CCS Track

LÓS ALTOS HILLS — Any one still unconvinced that the current crop of prep track and field athletes is one of the best in area history certainly didn't see Saturday's Central Coast Section finals.

Hundreds of sun-warmed spectators at Foothill College here saw a superb show of high school talent in which eight meet records tumbled and two more were tied.

Although Los Altos High and super runner Rick Brown again dominated the scene, SPAL athletes — Sequoia High in particular — grabbed more than their share of glory and, more important, places for this weekend's State Meet at Berkeley.

While Brown broke records set by a couple of pretty fair track stars — Lee Evans and Don Bowden — and led Los Altos to the team title with 60 points, the SPAL placed Gunn second and nabbed nine of the 48 CCS State Meet spots. Only the first three in each event qualified.

Only the Santa Clara Valley Athletic League, including Los Altos, had more qualifiers with 16. With Los Altos alone outscoring every other league, SCVAL competitors chalked up 118½ points to a still highly respectable 53 for the SPAL and 51½ for the Mid Peninsula League.

The smooth-striding Brown had an incredible triple — 47.1 in the 440, an amazing 1:50.7 in the 880, and a 46.5 anchor leg in Los Altos' 3:15.8 mile relay victory. All three marks are current state bests.

Olympian Evans held the old 440 mark of 48.1 set by Overfelt in 1965, while Bo

den, first American to crack four minutes in the mile, set the former 880 standard of 1:52.3 for Lincoln of San Jose in 1954.

Gunn's Julian Lucas was the SPAL's top performer, claiming first in the 180 low hurdles in 19.1, taking third in the 440 with the best time in SPAL history, 48.3, and anchoring Gunn's second-place mile relay team to another best in league history of 3:19.6.

Lucas' hurdles clocking broke the oldest CCS record, a 19.2 by current San Carlos coach Jim Luttrell for Sequoia in 1952.

Sequoia produced three State Meet entrants, including the surprise of the year.



Little junior Cezar Orayillo, who was on the junior varsity team part of the season, ran third in the 180 lows at 19.7 to stun his more well-known rivals.

"It's a pleasant surprise," said Cherokee coach Buddy Miller happily. "the way he's come on lately, I thought he had an outside chance."

Sequoian Jim May backflipped 6-6, using his own version of the Fosbury flop, to take a surprise first place and edge teammate Ron Bosch at the same height on fewer misses in the high jump.

May had to be one of the happiest athletes at the meet. "I knew I had it in me, I just had to do it. You know, I've never been able to do better than 5-4 any other way," he said in reference to his unusual style. May leaps over backwards aided by a terrific body twist.

Also winning State Meet tickets were Menlo-Atherton's Ken Murphy with a 23-5¾ long jump, Gunn's Dave Bagshaw at 14.6 in the high hurdles, and Carlmont's Hans Templeman at 9:31.8 in the two-mile. All took third places.

Running well but just failing to qualify at fourth were Donn Wells of Woodside with a 9:34.7 in the two mile and Gunn's Dave Eshelman at 14.6 in the high hurdles. Gunn's Dale Krebs took a fifth in the triple jump. Menlo-Atherton's Ernie Reese reinjured his leg while running in the 440 relay trials and had to scratch from the 100 trials.

West Catholic Athletic League winners were Serra's

Lynn Swann with a 24-2½ long jump, the Section's best, and Menlo Park resident Bob McCarty of St. Francis with a 9:25.0 two-mile.

Swann scratched in the 180 lows, hoping to get a chance to attend Serra's afternoon graduation ceremonies, but the long jump ran late and he had to miss graduation anyway.

Other meet records were set by Overfelt's 440 relay team at 42.5, Crestmoor's Chuck Bommartio in the 220 at 21.6, Cupertino's Craig Conway with a 48-9½ triple jump and Los Altos' Chris Adams with a 189-3½ discus flip.

Bommarito also tied the meet 100 record at 9.7, as did Los Altos' Vic Brooks with a 14.5 low hurdles clocking.

In addition, Karl Goldstone of San Mateo went 14-10 for the state's top pole vault, Dave Chamness of Awalt bettered his own CCS best in the mile at 4:14.6 and Adams lofted the shot 62-4, only 5½ inches short of his state best.

The SPAL had three impressive frosh-soph winners as Carlmont's Paul Dempster pole vaulted 13-0, Carlmont's Steve Miller clocked 4:24.0 in the mile and Woodside's Lamont Wiley hit 22.8 in the 220.

Ravenswood's Percy Pucket looked sharp in taking a 10.2 second place in the 100 and the Trojan mile relay team checked in third at 3:31.5.

The State Meet is for varsity performers only.
