I figured you for between 198 and 191 points and you didn't let yourself down. MAURICE had his greatest day ever as a track man. The way he responded to the pressure put on him by Roberts in the TJ was something to behold. He gets stronger and stronger in the 440 and looks like a real state contender. TIMMY, for the first time in his life, really looks STRONG. His finishes were superb. RON K. must learn to hold down that first lap in the mile and he will show some of the big schools what he is made of. KENNY, who had been sick all week, gave his all. His vault at 14 was great, but then at 14'6" the effects of the illness showed. He was very disappointed but I was proud of him. It looks like DAVE has won a place on the mile relay and RAYMOND ran hard for the first time this year. All in all, it was a pretty good feeling after the meet and I know how proud you all were. WEST COAST RELAYS next week will test you again... and then the BIG ones start.....
