SORRY THAT THERE AREN'T MORE PICTURES, ALTHOUGH I THINK THE TWO I'M SENDING ARE PRETTY GOOD STUDIES. WE HAVE A SCREW-UP WITH OUR PHOTOGS -- MM THESE, IF YOU USE THEM, SHOULD BE CREDITED TO E.W. HOPE.

AS USUAL, A LOT OF GUYS DIDN'T RUN -- ALTHOUGH IT WASN'T AS BAD AS IT HAS BEEN. MUNSON, STILL PREFONTAINE-SHOCKED, I THINK, DIDN'T ~~MMMM~~ COME, NOR DID WASHINGTON JUMPER BIRKINSHAW (SPRAINED ANKLE). WSU DIDN'T RUN ANY OF ITS DISTANCEMEN. YOU'LL NOTE A FEW EVENT SWITCHES HERE AND THERE.

OREGON HAD SOME OPPORTUNITIES IT DOESN'T GET IN DUAL MEETS, SINCE YOU COULD ENTER FOUR MEN IN AN EVENT. AND THE DUCKS DIDN'T PULL ANY PUNCHES.

PREFONTAINE'S TWO-MILE BROKE THE MEET RECORD FOR THE EVENT -- 9:03.5 BY DELLINGER IN ~~MMMM~~ 1956. SAID DELLINGER: "I'M ACTUALLY KIND OF GLAD TO GET THAT OFF THE BOOKS. IT'S EMBARRASSING -- HIGH SCHOOL KIDS RUN THAT FAST THESE DAYS."

IT WAS NOT, HOWEVER, THE FASTEST THE DISTANCE HAS BEEN RUN IN THIS MEET. LINDGREN HAD 8:37.6 EN ROUTE TO ~~MM~~ 12:53. CHAPLIN LISTS THAT AS THE RECORD, AND HE HAS A POINT.
