## QUOTES FROM THE CHAMPIONS:

Keith Tice.....Hammer: 23 year old junior from Fresno State majoring in PE.....  
threw lifetime best of 182-10 to win the event.....has only lost twice this  
season, at Mt. SAC and West Coast Relays.

"Naturally it felt good to win although I got off to a fouled up start."

The reason for the foul up was as follows: Tice sensed the ring was short and called it to the attention of the officials. After some fuss between coaches, officials, etc. they measured the ring and found it to be 4" short. There was more discussion between coaches and officials and competitors and it was ultimately decided to start the event over, making the event longer than it should have been.

"They did what they had to do (start the event over)," Tice said, "although it made for a very long afternoon. I felt in good shape, however, and was happy to win."

Tice is looking forward to the NCAA's "because they'll pay my way." He doesn't know whether he'll compete in the AAU's and has said that Modesto wants qualifiers to hit 190-feet plus. He has no definite target other than "to do my best effort every time out."

Mike Ritchie.....Steeplechase: 20 year old junior from Long Beach State majoring in business administration.....this was his seventh steeplechase and fourth that he's won.....he's only been competing in steeplechase for a year.

"I was a little nervous when I started but soon settle down. I had great respect for San Diego's Mike Cour. He was leading me when we competed in our dual meet and dropped out, so I never was certain whether I could beat him.

"I didn't want to lead early, but I felt pretty good and that's the way it turned out. This is a tactical race and you're interested in winning it more so than the time. The object is to win.

"I guess things went my way. I built up a cushion and after that it seemed easy going."

Arnie Robinson.....Triple jump: 23 year old senior from San Diego State majoring in PE.....

"It was great to win and the record (51-0) felt good. I was ready for Steel (Doyle) this time as I knew his capabilities, the last time I didn't. The competitive effort against him was helpful today.

"The conditions were great today and I am just real happy. There's not much more to say than that. As for my goals, I'd like to hit 27-feet in the long jump and I just do the best I can each time in the triple jump."



John Dean.....Mile: 19 year old sophomore from Cal State Los Angeles majoring in business administration.....

"The race was great and the conditions were perfect. I heard that this track was fast and it proved to be so. I was scared stiff of the wind, but it didn't bother me at all. This was my kind of race, the third lap especially was good. Buck Black (San Jose State) was in the lead and it allowed me to rest up for the final lap. I've been keying for this race and it came off perfectly.

George Carty.....120 HH: 24 year old senior from San Jose State majoring in recreation.....

"I was very happy to win although I am peaking for something better, to make the Olympic team. I just try to better my time each time I compete. The track was a little hard, but the weather conditions were perfect and that means a great deal. Running in cold weather is no good. The warm weather helps a lot."

Elmo Dees.....440: 23 year old senior from San Jose State majoring in recreation.....

"I was very pleased to win. It was my last competitive race for San Jose State and the victory is meaningful to me. I pulled up lame with a hamstring last week in Fresno and I was worried about competing in this meet. The doc took good care of me and I laid off all week. Things turned out very well here. I liked the track. It was a little hard, but good to run on."

John Tobin.....Javelin: 23 year old junior from UC Santa Barbara majoring in anthropology.....

"I've been psyching up for this one throw for the past six weeks. I had no mental blocks today whatsoever and my knee felt good. I want to keep it that way so I stopped after my first throw. The layoff really didn't bother me as much as I thought it might. I just relied on past experience to pull me through and it did. I feel I couldn't improve upon my first throw and I'm just happy that I did so well."

Greg Born.....Shot Put: 21 year old junior from San Jose State majoring in penology.....

Conditions were real good and I was satisfied with the win. I like my competition to be a bit better and it helps me to throw better. The caliber of the competition in this meet was not the best. Nevertheless I won and I am happy for that."

Lee Marshall.....880: Junior from San Jose State.....

"The track was awfully hard and I was scared of it at first because of shin splints in my right leg. I figured I'd have an awful time. As it turned out, the race came off well and I felt real strong on the last 220. It's a fast track. I'm satisfied with my time and I hope now to continue to compete into the summer where at first when I came into this meet I figured I'd call it quits after today. This race has revived my spirits."

Dennis Ruby.....440 IH: Junior from Cal State Long Beach majoring in PE.....

"It was great winning. I had thought I'd break 52 seconds but not by that much. It was a great feeling. I knew that it would be between King and myself but I was worried as I was running in lane 8 and couldn't see what King was doing. He was in lane 2 and could see me. I had nobody to gage my race on. As it turned out, I won and that's what counts. It was a great race and I'm very happy and satisfied."

Nii Addo Allotey.....100 and 220: 26 year old senior from Cal State Los Angeles majoring in journalism.....

"I have no complaints whatsoever. Both races were good and I was very happy to win. I nearly pulled up at around 80 yards in the 100 and I thought I was finished. I considered not running in the 220, but then went ahead anyway just to see what would happen. Nothing happened and everything came out for the best. I'm very happy about that. This has been a good meet and the track, although it's slightly hard, is a good one to run on."

Arnie Robinson.....Long jump: 23 year old senior from San Diego State majoring in PE.....

"I thought I did pretty well overall. I hurt my heel yesterday and it bothered me for the first three jumps today, but it didn't really have an effect. I'm satisfied with my two day's work (Robinson took fourth in the high jump at 6-4). I'm working with the weights a lot, two or three times a week, to build up my legs. That's very important. My next big meet will be at Modesto and I really want to win the NCAA this year. It will take a high 26-foot jump to win it."

Otis Martin.....three and six miles: 22 year old junior from San Diego State majoring in PE.....

"I felt awfully tired yesterday. My muscles were tight and I was concerned about running today. I was hanging back to preserve my energy when I needed it down the stretch and I had to pour it on then. I really felt taxed, but was able to put out the kick when I had to. I'm very pleased with the wins and I think I'll rest for awhile until the NCAA's."

Vic Dias.....Pole vault: 23 year old from San Jose State majoring in PE.....

"I was very happy to win, but that cross wind was bad and slowed me down a lot. Also, I didn't come into today's meet with the best physical condition as I felt bloated from a slight case of the flu. I'm certain that I'll reach my peak by the AAU meet and I'm looking forward to hitting that 17-foot barrier again."

Jerry Culp.....High jump: 19 year old freshman from San Diego State majoring in social science.....

"I'm happy to win but was disappointed with my effort. I remodified my form earlier this week, working on my trailing leg. I changed from a straight to a bent trailing in hopes of speeding up my turn. I may have concentrated too much on that which was my big mistake and consequently I didn't do as well as I would have liked. Yet to win was the big thing and I'm happy for that."
