SAN JOSE — Carlmont High finished a close second to Willow Glen in a special high school distance medley race run along with the San Jose State-Stanford track meet here Saturday.

Stanford's Depth Wins Close Meet

SAN JOSE — Three minutes before the start of the mile relay, Stanford team captain Rick Tipton looked among an encircling group of teammates and made his choice.

"Okay," he said, "it'll be you, you and you," indicating Pete Fairchild, Tom Long and Randy White. He had already nominated himself to run the anchor leg.

Despite little time to prepare mentally, the team ran 3:14.5, fastest by a Stanford team in three years, and clinched a 78-68 victory over San Jose State, the first in four seasons.

"We had eight men ready to run the mile relay," Coach Payton Jordan said. "I talked to all of them, trying to determine who was ready and fresh enough to compete, then left the decision up to Tipton.

"All eight wanted to run and all have about equal times. It was a difficult decision."

White Breaks Race

Stanford trailed at the mid-way point but White broke the race open by making up five yards on San Jose's James Love and building a 10 yard lead. Tipton ran a very smooth final leg and the margin widened to 3.4 seconds at the finish.

A victory for San Jose in the relay, coupled with Bob Richards' dramatic victory over Casey Carrigan of Stanford in the pole vault (both cleared 16-7), would have given the Spartans a 73-72 victory.

"We just plain ran out of people," San Jose coach Ernie Bullard said. "Injuries prevented us from using Chuck Sundsten, Len Gaskill and Kirk Clayton, yet we stayed close until the end. They did everything they could.

"I just hope the season doesn't continue like this. We have three new injuries every week it seems. This is a good team and I think that will show up yet."

Spartan Changes

The succession of injuries caused any number of lineup changes.

- Middle distance racer Buck Black dropped out of the 880 when it became apparent that teammate Lee Marshall was in command. Marshall won the race in 1:51.4 and Black was then inserted into the mile relay.

- Elmo Dees ran the 220

as a replacement for Clayton, in addition to his normal duties in the quartermile and mile relay. He came away with a 47.2 victory in the 440 and a second in the 220 at 21.6.

- With Gaskill out with a hamstringing injury, George Carty was forced to run the 440 intermediate hurdles and finished last. Carty had earlier won the high hurdles in 13.8 and said he wasn't in shape to run either the intermediates or the mile relay.

Stanford had to scratch Duncan MacDonald in the mile because of illness and he finished fourth, out of the points, in the 880.

Lifetime Bests

Nine athletes had lifetime bests for Stanford but only Don Kardong's 4:03.9 in the mile supplied a victory. It was also the only Bud Winter Field record.
