## Sports Shorts

The women's track team took first place Saturday by a half point in a five way track meet with Ventura College Cal Poly Pomona, UC-Riverside, Pomona College, and Cal Poly San Luis Obispo.

San Diego State edged Ventura with a 102.5 to 102 score.

Jan Lundie placed first in the long jump setting a new San Luis Obispo track record with a 17-1 $\frac{1}{4}$  leap. She also finished third in the 100-yard dash with a 12.3 time. Nancy Thwing of San Luis Obispo won the race with an 11.6 clocking.

Mallia Boulio crossed the finish

line in the 100 meter high hurdle race with the winning time of 18.5.

Both Aztec relay teams placed second. The 880 relay team of Angie Ludy, Janie Recher, Miss Boulio, and Barbara Amado finished with a 2:06.3 time.

The 440 relay team of Jan Lewis, Miss Ludy, Miss Boulio, and Miss Lundie finished second with 58.4 despite the baton being dropped on the final pass.

In the fielding events, the Aztecs made a fine showing. Liz Augustine won the discus event

with a 98-4 measure. She placed second in the shot put with a 29-11 effort.

High jumper Miss Amado placed second at 4-4 on more misses. Becky White of Riverside was first at the same height. Miss Recher was third at 4-2.

In the javelin, Miss Recher was second with a measure of 87-4 $\frac{1}{2}$ . Sue Minnock was third with a 78-3 mark. The winning distance was 90-4 by Joyce Walker of San Luis Obispo.
