SPAL Will Send Nine By KEVIN DOYLE Ravenswood's 440-relay Steve Buss into one more meet

Tribune Sports Writer SAN JOSE — The prep track season ended for all but nine of the SPAL's best here Saturday night in the Central Coast Section track and field finals at San Jose City College.

Ravenswood High's makeshift 440 relay team and five other athletes spread over six events qualified for the State Meet at UCLA Friday and Saturday.

Sequoia's Cezar Oravillo finished second in the 180 low hurdles and because of a misfortune to another SPAL cinderman qualified in the high hurdles to lead SPAL entries.

Oravillo ran the race of his life in the lows at 19.1, only to finish second to Mark Skillman of Campbell (18.9) and snuck into the climax of the season when Gunn's Dave Bagshaw fell in the high hur-• dles.

Bagshaw, who blitzed to a 14.2 meet record clocking in the high hurdle trials, was outclassing the field going into the last hurdle when he stumbled and did not finish, allowing Oravillo to finish in the third and final State spot. Ravenswood's 440-relay team, which was notified Wednesday that it was given a hardship berth into Saturday morning's trials, finished second in 42.8 to Monterey to gain the trip to the Southland. Coach Roy Shivers will take his team of Ed Johnson, Ernest Spencer, Darrell Augmon and Joe Prince with him Friday, but injured James Shirley won't be able to join them.

Carlmont's Hans Templeman gained his second trip to the State finale while Scot junior pole vaulter Paul Dempster earned his first berth.

Templeman finished third in the two-mile to Willow Glen's Bob Ebert and Soquel's Mark McConnell but should do better than both of them in LA this weekend.

According to Loren Lansberry, Templeman's coach, the senior distance ace missed the entire week of workouts with an illness and was running on poise and guts alone.

Templeman finished a distant third at 9:19.6 behind Ebert's meet record performance of 9:08.8 and McConnell's 9:16.3.

Dempster came through with one of the most surpris-

ing efforts of the meet for loc a l participants when he cleared 14-0 to finish second in the pole valut behind Camd e n's Roger Martin, who cleared 15-6.

Despite Bradshaw's misfortune, the Titans did manage to put Dale Krebs and Steve Buss into one more meet this season. Krebs finished second in the triple jump with a leap of 46-11% while Buss finished one notch lower in the discus with a heave of 170-2.

Woodside's Rich Jones missed by an inch of making the State meet in the long jump (21-11) and also finished fourth in the highs behind Oravillo with a 14.6 clocking.

Carlmont's Mike Hall picked up a medal with a fifth place finish in the triple jump (45-31/2) while Woodside's Dave Legg finished fifth in the 440 (49.8) behind the 48.2 of Sunnyvale's Ben Brown.

The only track performer to record a double was Crestmoor's Chuck Bommarito who won the 100 (9.8) and averaged an early season loss to Brown by capturing the 220 in 21.4 for a meet record.

Cupertino, behind Craig Conway's 49-5 meet record triple jump, won the team title with 18 points to Awalt's 17.

Local athletes fared well in the season-ending CCS froshsoph finals with several outstanding efforts.

Serra's Clyde Lamont was the only frosh-soph double winner at 8.8 in the 70 high

hurdles and 20.2 in the 180 lows, and teammate Bob Price captured the 100 in 10.2. From the SPAL, San Carlos' Bruce, yeal took the 440 in 50.7, tying his life best, and Carlmont's Carl Cattarin, topped the two-mile field in 9:42.2.

Second place finishes, went to Veal (long jump), Carlmont's Jack Lennen (pole vault), Gunn's Steve Crowley (mile), Palo Alto's Carl Florant (high hurdles) and Cubberley's Rick Farmer (high jump).
