

Acorn Trackman 'Super-Sensational'

PEBBLE BEACH — Menlo School track coach Bob Jones is convinced John Crockett stepped out of a storybook.

Crockett, a freshman from East Palo Alto who has earned a varsity baseball letter this spring, decided to compete in the Coast Athletic Association frosh-soph track finals and upstaged his varsity teammates with "a super-sensational showing," said Jones.

"The kid was amazing, considering he had never trained for track," said Jones. Crockett won the high jump at 6-1, the long jump at 19-7, was second in the 100 at 10.5 and ran a leg of Menlo's winning relay team.

The Acorns easily domi-

nated both divisions and captured most of the first places over host Robert Louis Stevenson and York.
