TERRY GALAGHER WINS 30KILOMETER MARATHON

Feb. 20, Newton, Mass.——Terry Galagher fought off 20 mph head winds and one foot of snow to win the 6th Annual Silver Lake Marathon. The 26 year old insurance man from Arlington, Mass. took the lead right from the start and bested the field of 120 pavement pounders in the spectacular time of 1:48:30. In winning the race, Gallagher became the N.E.A.A.U. 30 Kilometer Junior Champion. In a distant second place, Ron Wayne of the B.A.A. crossed the line in the time of 1:51:15, and in third place, Wayne Frongello also of the B.A.A. crossed the line inthe time of 1:51:34. The icy wind blown course followed the same route as the Boston Marathon, until 17½ miles where it detoured so it could finish in front of Silver Lake Dodge. The record for this course is 1:46:01 set last year by Ed Walkwitz.
