

THE 1972 ALL NORTHERN CALIFORNIA TRACK & FIELD TEAM

The Northern California Track & Field Association presents the 1972 All Northern California High School Track Team. This team has been selected annually since 1966.

This team was selected on the following criteria: (1) Place in the state meet trials and finals; (2) Place in the section meet; (3) Best mark. Place in the state meet finals was the most important of all factors in making the team.

The area that the athletes were chosen from is geographical rather than sectional. Athletes south of the Modesto-Turlock area and south of Salinas were not considered on this team as they more properly belong to a Central California grouping.

Scott Overton of Los Altos and Mike Shavers of Albany were the only repeaters from last years mythical team.

Junior distance-running sensation Steve Miller of Carlmont High is the lone upper Peninsulan to win a place on the annual All-Northern California prep track and field team.

The team, selected by Menlo-Atherton coach Plato Yanicks, is picked by considering place in the state meet, section final and best mark together. Place in the state meet is the key factor.

Miller was chosen as one of two milers, along with El Cerrito's famed Dale Scott, following his 4:10.7 third place effort in the state finals.

Seven state champions are included on the team; Miller

and Albany sprinter Mike Shavers are the lone juniors, and Shavers and Los Altos national discus record-holder Scott Overton are the only repeat ers.

Athletes were chosen from a geographical rather than strictly sectional area, since it was felt those south of the Modesto-Turlock and Salinas areas more properly belong to a Central California grouping. The complete selection:
