Sutton Ties MBL Vault Record

Gary McConnell took third in the two-mile run with a personal best time of 9:34.6. That time ties his brother Mark's best time as a junior.

Lee Rudnick, also of Soquel, placed third in the long jump at 21-034 and fifth in the triple jump with a school record jump of 44-7. In addition, the Knights' 440 relay team (Greg Feaster, Rudnick, Steve VanDenHeuvel

and Scott Thorne) was fourth in that event with a time of 45.1.

Dennis Meakin of Santa Cruz led his team with a second place in the pole vault, behind Sutton, at 13-0. John Armstrong placed fifth in the 2-mile with a personal best time of 10:18.0.

Santa Cruz' Mike Scofield won first place in the 180 low hurdles with a personal best time of 21.6. The SC 440 relay team (Scofield, Rick Bastine, Rich Vanslager and Rick Paris) ran a season best time of 46.7 in the finals of that event.

Soquel's mile relay team won that frosh-soph event with a time of 3:38.2. Running legs on the relay were Scott Meyer. Marty Capron. Dave Capron and John Walder.

Marty Capron placed in two individual events. He was second in the high hurdles for a school record of 9.6. Phil Kitchen was third with a time of 9.8.
