Don't be surprised if the winner of Friday night's SPAL track and field championships outstanding field performer award goes to a sophomore who isn't even on the varsity.

Woodside High's Myrt Easbattle with San Carlos' Cais In comparision qualifying for the SPAL championships yesterday at Foothill College.

Easley's mark - only a little better than Malveaux leap of 45-101/2 - will be carried over to Friday's finals along with all top field marks with the exception of the high jump and pole vault.

The league's outstanding performers are selected from a scoring chart submitted by the C.I.F. and used to select the best athlete in the State Meet as well as the Regional and Central Coast Section,

In comparision, it will take a 13-9 pole vault, a 6-5 high jump or a 57-0 shot put to take the award away from one of the greatest sophomore athletes in SPAL history.

Varsity qualifying took a turn toward the unimpressive because most of the top athletes were seeded into the finals and most of the field marks which carry over - were below seasonal pars.
