

... Held in Drake Stadium, UCLA, Saturday, April 13, 1974







THIS MAY BE UCLA'S HOME FINALE but it's not the last chance to see the '74 Bruins in action locally. Coming up are the Mt. San Antonio Relays April 27, the big one with USC in Memorial Coliseum May 4 and then on May 17-18, also in the Coliseum, they'll be striving to defend their Pac-8 title, the coveted conference crown they've won four of the past five years (1969-70-71-73).

Scoring for Today's Dual Meet: 5 - 3 - 1 for individual events; 5 - 0 for relay races. There are 154 total points in this 18-event meet.

Season Results to Date: Oregon has split two dual meets, defeating Arizona State, 84-70, but losing to Washington, 90-73. UCLA has now won six dual meets to run its three-season win streak to 23 in a row. The Bruins have defeated Arizona, 87-53; San Diego State, 106-38; San Jose State, 87-56; Long Beach State, 108-32; Tennessee, 80-72; and California, 92-52.

UCLA 5, Oregon 0: Yes, the Bruins have never lost to the Ducks in five previous dual meets, winning 91-54 in 1966, 85-59 in 1967, 81-73 in 1970, 86-59 in 1971 and 92-62 last year.

Gentlemen, We Thank You: Yes, in this final home program of 1974 we take this opportunity to salute track and field's "best friends," the officials of the Southern Pacific Assn. of the Amateur Athletic Union who serve today and every meet without any remuneration other than the satisfaction of helping the sport they love.

Today's Coaching Staffs: Oregon's head coach is Bill Dellinger, who succeeded Bill Bowerman last spring. He's ably assisted by Rainer Stinius, Dave Fix, Frank Morris and Les Tipton. UCLA's headman is Jim Bush, now in his 10th season since taking over from "Ducky" Drake in 1965. He's ably assisted by Tom Tellez, Hal Harkness and Len Dodson.


