### 1974 DUAL MEET ALL-AMERICA TEAM

The Dual Meet All-America team is a rather specialized group; only dual meet competition is considered in selecting team members. National championships are meaningless in this context. 1974's dual meet all-star group is missing NCAA champs in seven events, and over 5 per cent of the team did not score in the NCAA at Austin.

We'd like to especially thank our panel of experts who helped select the team.
