Johnson was knocked to the infield by the force of the toss and did not finish. The injury was diagnosed as a severe bruise, but is not expected to hamper his training. On the more serious side, USC sprinter Guy Abrahams pulled up in the first section of the open 100 with a hamstring pull and is feared out for the remainder of the season.

UCLA convincingly clinched the 1974 Dual Meet Championship with its 82 - 63 triumph over rival Southern Cal. The Trojans were actually running two points ahead of our dope sheet through the 440 (down 36 - 23 rather than the projected 38 - 21). USC figured to make a move in the 880, IH, and 220 to tighten things up; instead the Bruins won all three events (and a 17 - 10 scoring edge) to put the meet out of reach. UCLA heroes were many, but Jerry Herndon in the LJ, Gordon Peppars with a surprise 220 win, 2nd in the 100, and a come-from-behind (on the final pass) anchor on the 440 relay, and Tony Veney in the 880 stand out.

UCLA had a few injury problems that could have cost them the meet had not the rest of the Bruins come through in the clutch. Jim Neidhart sat out the meet with a hyper-extended elbow (suffered at Mt. SAC Tom Kovacich (doped for 3rd in the 880 was injured, and Maxie Parks strained or pulled a hamstring during the sprint relay. The extent of Parks' injury will not be fully known for a couple of days.

The only foulup in an otherwise well-conducted meet was the absence of a wind gauge. In a meet of this importance, it's rather ridiculous to possibly deprive athletes of legitimate NCAA qualifying marks due to the negligence of officials. The sprints and hurdles appeared to be run into the wind, however the horizontal jumpers appeared to have a mild wind behind them on most jumps. Some of those marks are very probably legal, but there is no way to officially verify this.
