# Shasta High captures sectional track title

OROVILLE — A Northern Athletic League team won the North Section California Interscholastic Federation track and field championships at Mitchell Field yesterday, the Shasta High Wolves breaking an Eastern Athletic League barrier that has become stronger with the years.

Chico used to win the sectional title with regularity as an NAL team, but no Redding area team has ever won.

Coaches Bill Schmidt and Joe McFarland had only one champion, Mark Elwell in the 440, but picked up six seconds, three of them by Mitch Webb, two thirds, two fourths and one fifth for 41 points.

Behind the Wolves came Paradise and Chico with 25 points each, Pleasant Valley with 20 and Wheatland with 19.

Elwell ran the quarter in 50.4 for the only Shastan gling to the state. Webb was second in the high and low hurdles and in the discuss. Mike Jensen was second in the 880 and both relay teams finished second. Eric Vollmers got a third in the long jump, Elwell a third in the 220, Terry Osborn fourth in high hurdles and the same in the lows, Keith Malain fifth in the mile.

Curt Parks of McCloud repeated his sectional title in the 100 and Tom Olson of Central Valley won the mile, Greg Bullard of Enterprise his third straight high jump — he won as a freshman in that division and as a sophomore in the junior-varsity ranks — with one to go. The Hornet junior was also second in the long jump. Parks was second in the 220. Luce Bortelleto of Enterprise was fourth in the high jump, Pete Van Matre of Trinity High fifth in the high hurdles and discuss, Bill Von der Mehden of the Falcons fifth in the 880, Tom Brown of Happy Camp fourth in the triple jump, Rod Baumback of Yreka third in the 100, CV's Don Fredrickson third in the high jump.

A winner from the Evergreen League was Steve Henson of Big Valley of Bieber with a 9:50.4 in the two-mile run.

Champions go to the state meet in Bakersfield next weekend.

Chico High took the junior-varsity division and Nova won its sixth straight freshman title with 73 points, just what

they scored last year. Mike Coe was the only JV winner, the Central Valley sophomore taking the discuss. Nova won both relays, Don Hoff the shot, Tim Gelonek the high jump, Bob Schmitt the intermediate hurdles, Rick Sanders the 880, Gary Swanson the pole vault, Dave Fuller the discuss.
