UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Seasons of Sport

The affirmation of the three seasons of sport by the CCS Board of Managers was discussed. Concerning the probability of Leagues following the change, most representatives felt their Leagues would, however, Monterey Peninsula will discuss and decide next week.

Discussion was held regarding the number of teams to be fielded by each League for 1976-77. The concern exprssed was that plans be made bafore September. The possibility of some Leagues cutting both boys and girls teams was also discussed. Mary Ross stated the FAL had done this and that the following would be offered for the girls next year: 2 Field Hockey; 3 Volleyball; 2 Swim; 2 Tennis; 3 Basketball; 1 Soccer; 2 Softball; 1 Gymnastics (with open/school division); 2 Track and 2 Badminton. She further stated they will have a coach per team except in Badminton which will be coached by one person. Other Leagues are considering the possibilities of having Varsity and Junior Varsity levels in most sports.

Starting Dates

Discussion led to agreement that Leagues will return to the meeting with some suggested starting dates for each sport in the girls program for the 1976-77 school year.

Regional/Sectional Dates

The proposed dates were discussed and some changes made. Copy attached.

Coaching Survey/Sport Committees

Joyce asked that the names of head coaches for each sport in every League be turned in by the June meeting. Each League will also designate a representative for the Sport Committees which will be organized for 1976-77. The names of the ADs should also be given on the form.

SPORT REPORTS

Gymnastics

The reasons for the meet being changed to the open/school concept, after a request by the CCS Coordinator to eliminate those divisions, was discussed. Joyce reported the unauthorized purchase of awards and other items by the Committee. The party responsible, the principal of her school, and the League President habe been notified that the CCS office will not reimburse costs for those items. A financial report is forthcoming.

Volleyball

The Sectional at San Jose State was very successful and well organized due to the efforts of Ann Sutherland, Menlo-Atherton. Letters have been sent to those responsible for the meet and thanks expressed. There should be approximately a \$400 profit from the VB Regionals & Sectional.

Track & Field

The women involved with the main responsibilities for the Qualifying Meet (May 22) will meet next week to discuss the progress made thusfar.

Softball

OTHER REPORTS

Staff Meeting

Joyce reported that the CCS staff will be meeting soon to discuss plans for the remainder of the school year and to discuss priorities for 1976-77. The question of a fulltime woman coordinator for the girls program was again discussed. The League representatives present felt that a written request for this service should be sent to the CCS Board of Managers. Joyce stated that Leagues may choose to do this if they wish, however, the proper procedure would be to direct the request to Mr. Arnold rather than the CCS Board of Managers.

Coastal Valley Board of Officials Mary Ross reported that the Board is planning to present a revised fee schedule to the CCS Board of Managers. This will bring fees to parity for the men and women officials now officiating the girls' contests. An experimental officiating program to train and evaluate softball officials was conducted by Jan Nay (Leland) and has been completed. Do NOT pay softball officials the full fee until notified by Jan whether or not the official has passed the practical examination.
